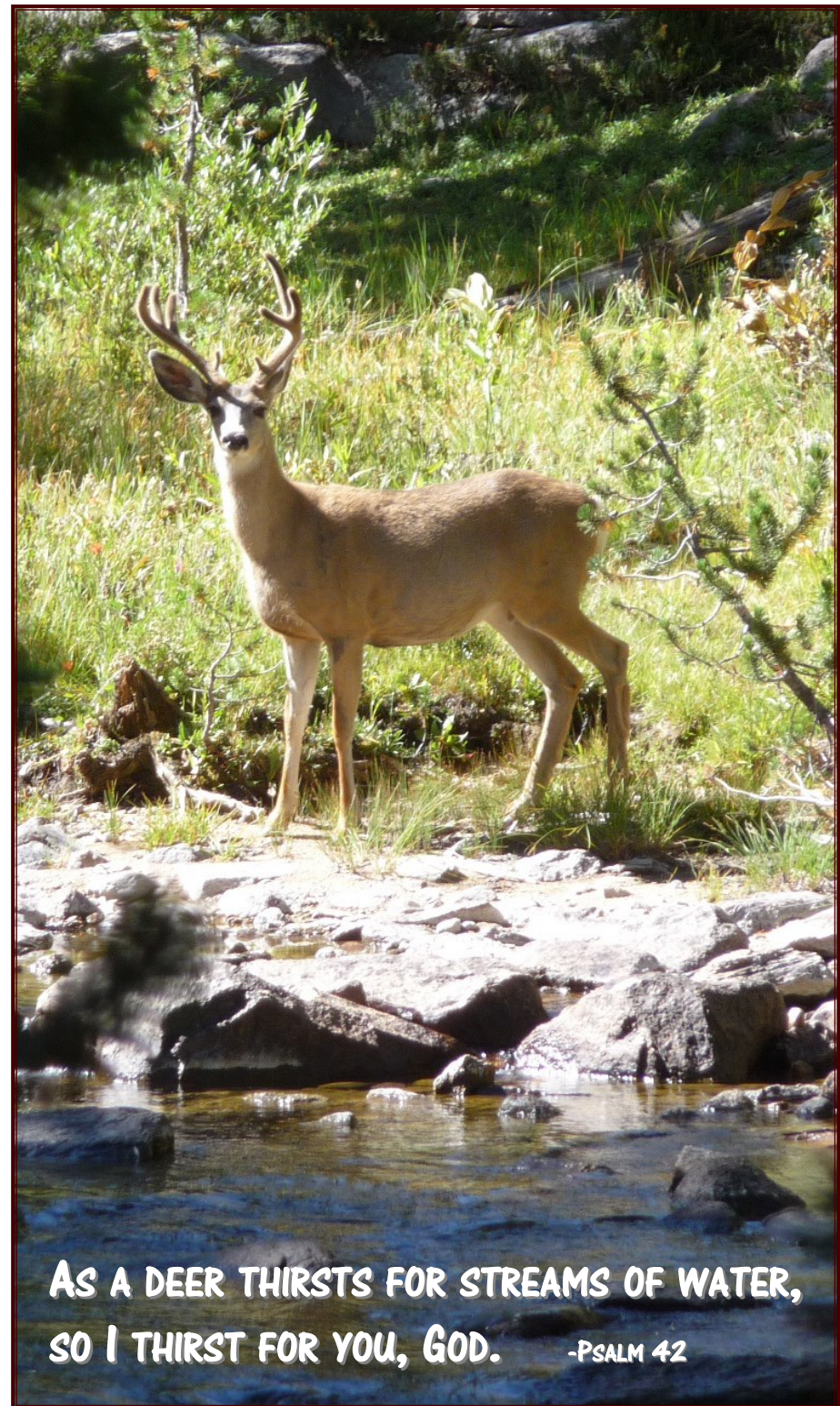
Christy Lay was born on March 23, 1960 in Seattle WA to Miles. C. Lay and Arlene Heinz.
