Lora Morris Stark, 85, West Fargo, ND died on Sunday, Sept. 9, 2018 at Bethany on University in Fargo, ND.

Lora Mae Nelson, known to many as "Bub," was born on February 27, 1933 on the family farm near Fargo, ND to Rudy and Beryl (Boyd) Nelson. She grew up on the family farm and attended rural school district #76 near Horace, ND. She graduated from West Fargo High School, received her teacher's degree from Valley City State and later her bachelor's and master's degrees from Moorhead State. Lora taught in rural schools at Durbin and Horace, ND. She married George W. Morris on June 12, 1954 at Norman Lutheran Church near Kindred, ND.
