Geraldine (Gerry) Francis (Waldorf) Huwe, born September 30, 1942 to Joe and Bernice (Fiedler) Waldorf of Perham, MN, passed on Monday, April 8, 2019 at Bethany on 42nd at the age of 76.

Gerry graduated in 1960 from Perham High School. She attended Beauty School in Fergus Falls, MN. Upon graduating in 1961, she moved to Minneapolis, MN and worked as a hairdresser at Jackie Ann's from 1961-1966. She then worked at Honeywell Inc. of Golden Valley, MN until May of 1968 when she was married.
