The absolute love of his life, Emily Jane, was born November 16, 2002.

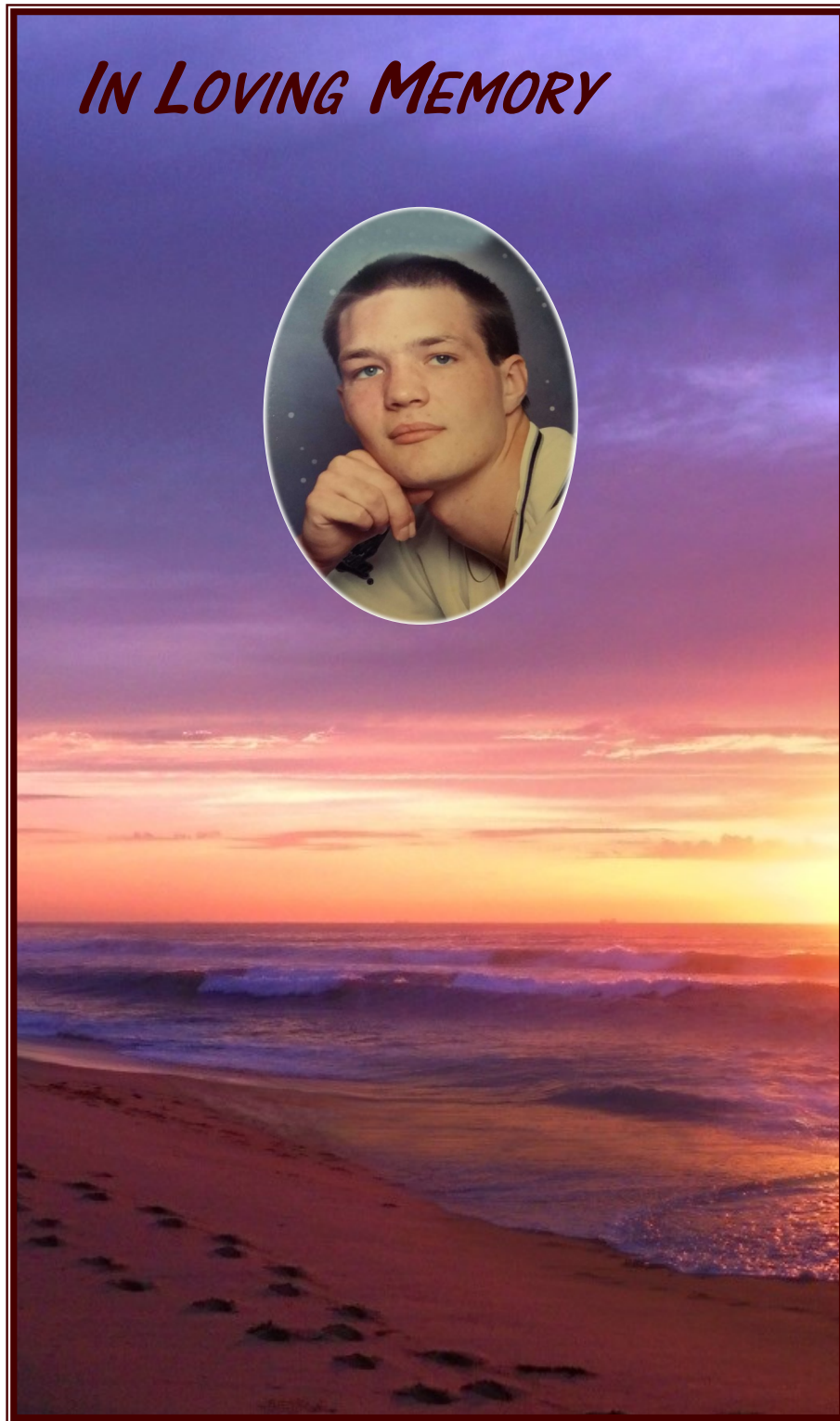
