

Remembering the life of....

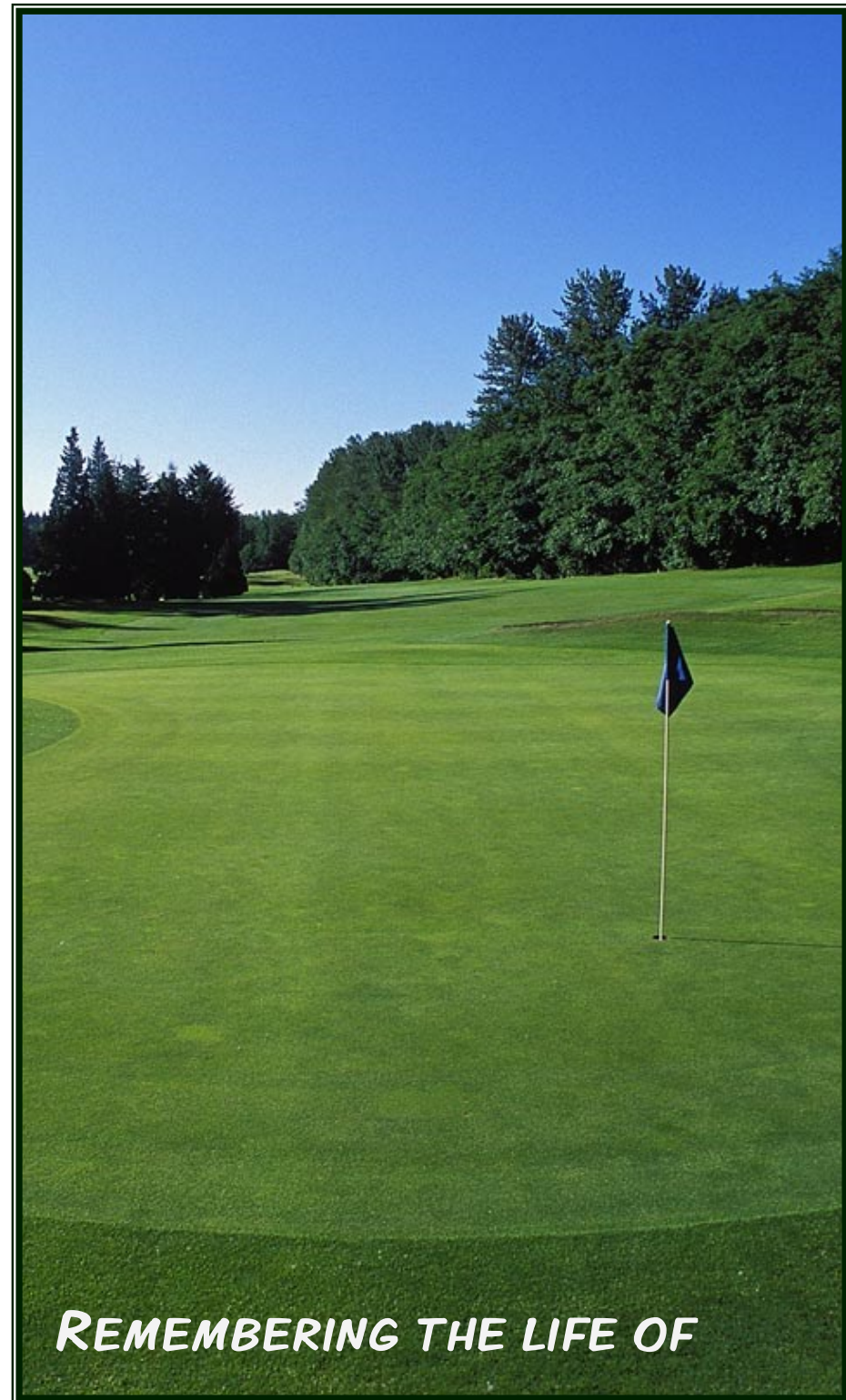
Phyllis Petersen, 92, Casselton, ND, died Saturday, June 15, 2019, at her home.
