REMEMBERING THE LIFE OF

Calvin Gene Scherling, 91, West Fargo, ND, died on March 8, 2020, in his home under the care of Hospice of the Red River Valley.

Calvin, known as Cal, was born on August 4, 1928, in Crosby, MN, to David and Doris (McCarthy) Scherling. He grew up and graduated high school in Little Falls, MN. He then attended St. Cloud State University earning a degree in business. Calvin served his country during the Korean War and was discharged from the Army with the rank of Sargent First Class.



Calvin married Ida Stromquist on October 18, 1958 in Little Falls, MN. They made their home in Bismarck, ND, Minot, ND, and settled in West Fargo in 1966. Cal worked as an insurance adjuster for State Farm Insurance for 32 years.
