Following his high school graduation in 1967 from Argusville High School, he attended Moorhead Technical College for Refrigeration and Air Conditioning. Gary served active duty in the United States Air Force from 1968-1972. Following his service, he worked in the Heating, Air Conditioning, and pipefitting business across many states. Gary was a proud member of the Plumbers and Pipefitters Local #338 since August, 1976; and spent several years teaching apprentice classes.
