A celebration of life for Lois will be held at a later date.

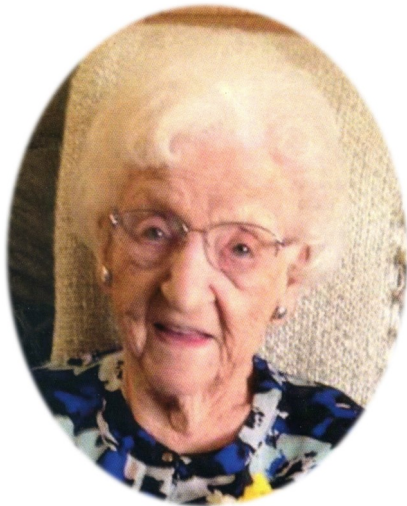
