IlaVey Kickertz 93, of Chaffee, N.D. passed away peacefully Tuesday, March 2, 2021 at Maryhill Manor, Enderlin, ND.

IlaVey was born on August 9, 1927 at McVille, ND to George and Ida (Pederson) Schmeck. She grew up on the family farm near Ayr, ND. IlaVey graduated from Ayr High School in 1945. She attended Valley City State Teachers College and graduated in 1947 after which she accepted an elementary teaching position in Chaffee, ND. This is where she met the love of her life, Alfred R.
