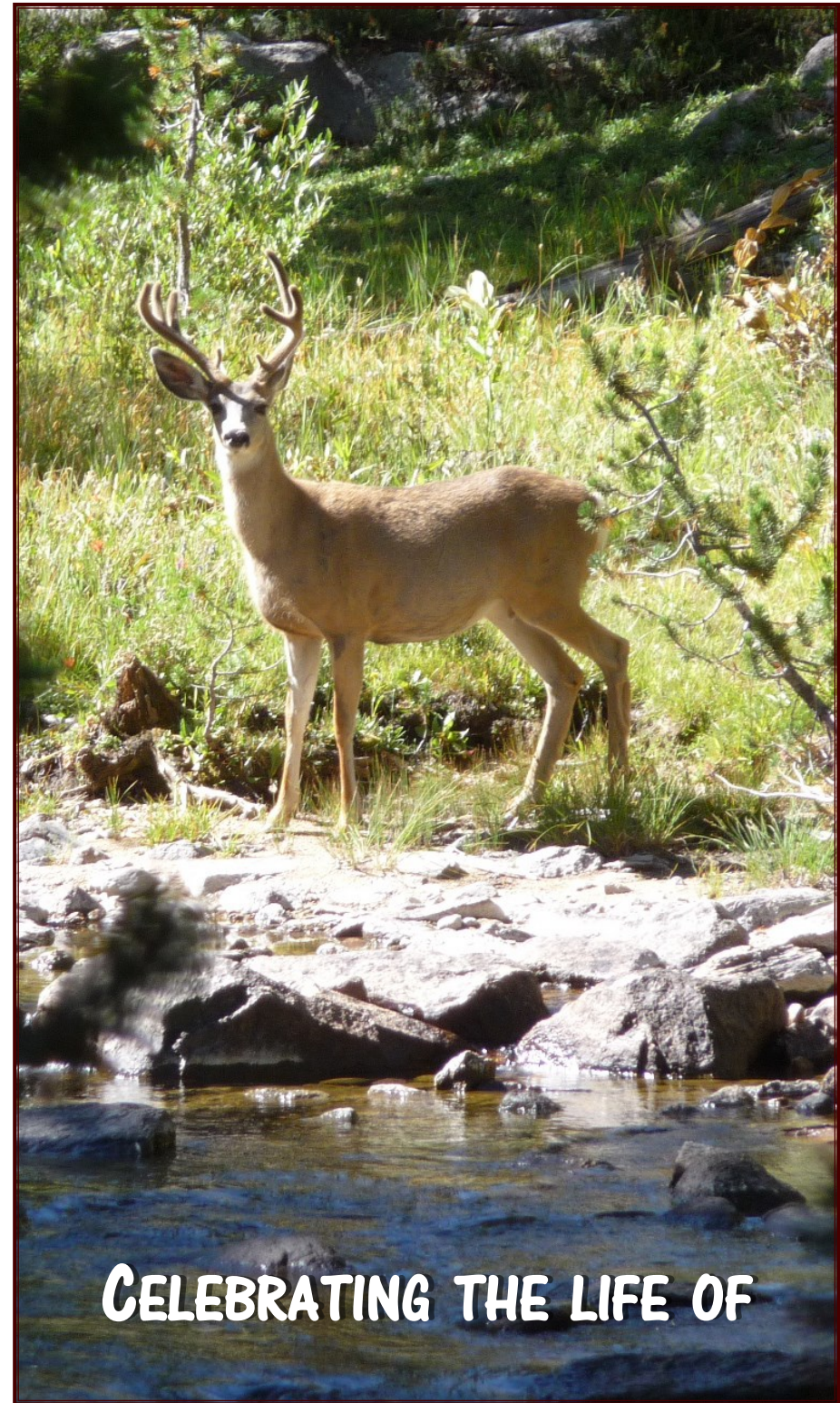
Daryl married Jill Nevos on June 21, 1997.
