Kenneth Carl Schossow, 73, of West Fargo, passed away, Saturday, July 10, 2021, at The Meadows in Fargo.

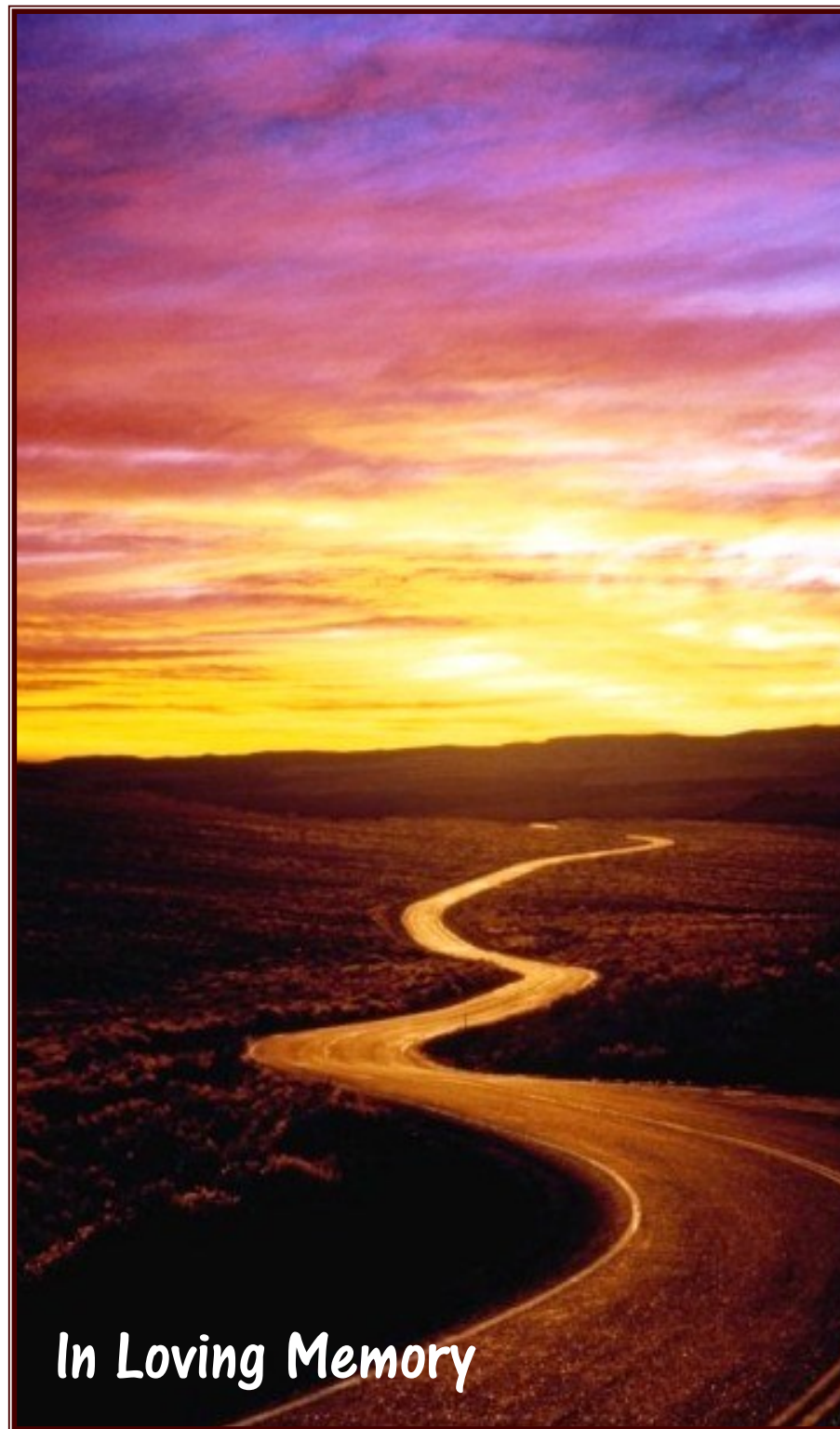
