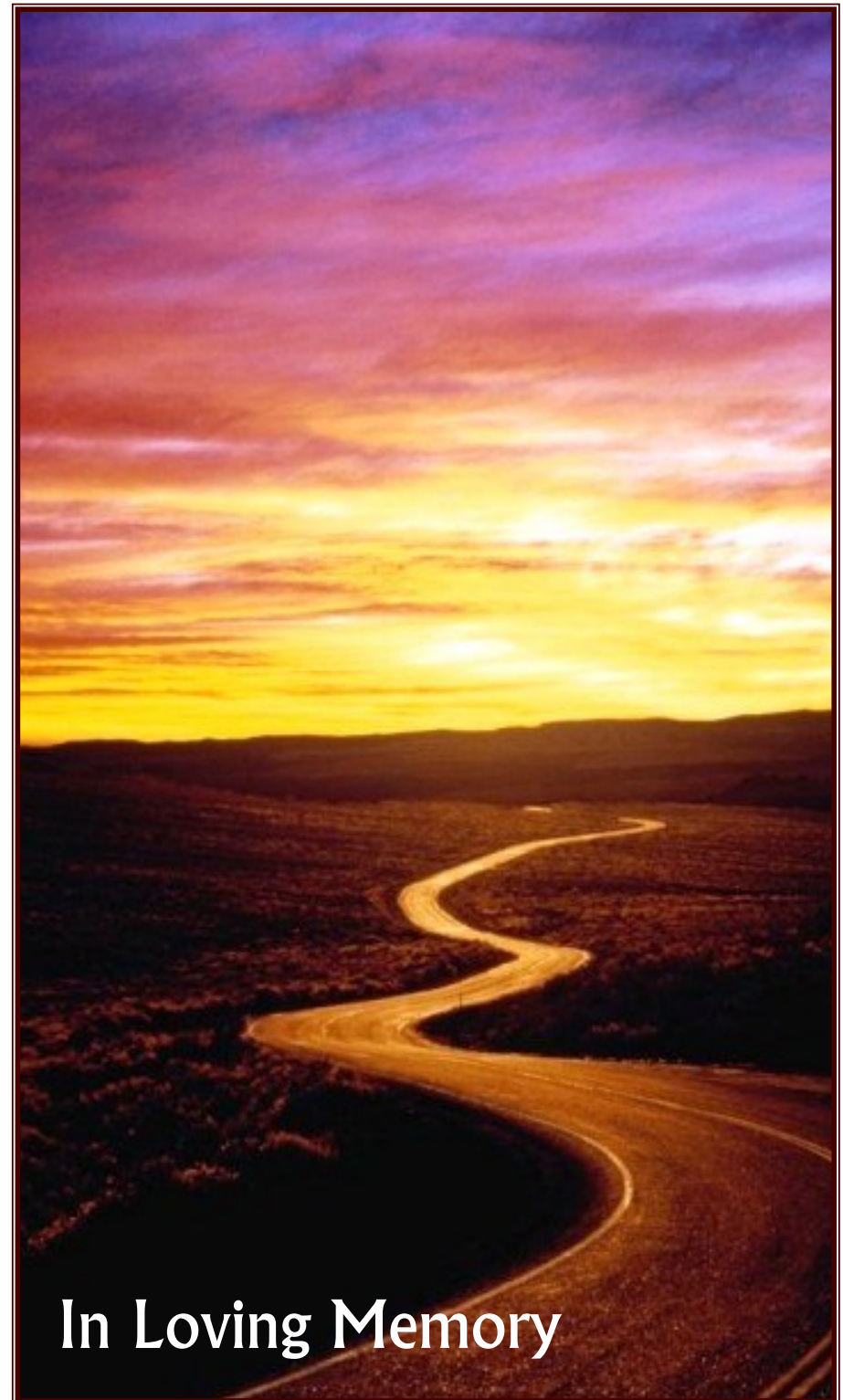
He married Sandy (Wobbema) Rogers October 31, 1987. She brought two children to the marriage, Christopher and Jessica. They divorced in 2009.
