

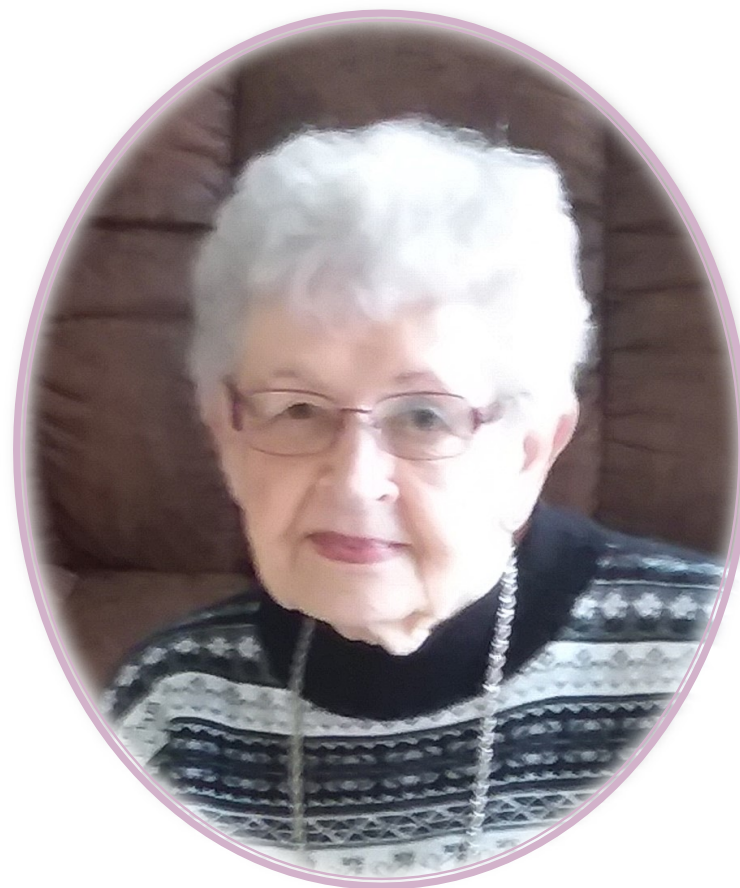
### *Remembering the life of....*

Audrey “Auntie Aud” Hahn, age 97, of Fargo, ND, died Friday, March 25, 2022, at Sanford Hospice House, Fargo.

Audrey Ardella Hahn was born February 28, 1925, to parents John and Mabel (Schoessow) Hahn in Alice, ND. Audrey was the 6<sup>th</sup> of 11 children: Evelyn, Wallace, Charlotte, Bernard, Lavern, Rita, Delores, Kent, John Jr. and Jeanette. Audrey grew up on the family farm where her father owned and operated the Hahn Seed Co.

Audrey had an eight-grade education, having stayed home to help with the family. She also helped her mom with the farm near Chaffee following the death of her father. In 1949/1950 Audrey moved to Fargo and worked at Herbst cafeteria one year. In 1951, she worked at St. John’s Hospital for five years in the newborn nursery. After getting a hairdresser license from New York School of Hairdressing in 1957, she went to work at deLendrecie's Beauty Hairdressing for two years. In 1959, Audrey and her sister Charlette started Petite Beauty Salon. After selling the salon to her sister in 1969, Aud and niece Diana then started up Lisa Ann’s Beauty studio as an in-home salon. There she worked 53 years until she retired at the age of 85.

Audrey was secretary for Fargo Hairdressers affiliate #8 for many years. She enjoyed quilting at First Lutheran Church, and fellowship on Wednesday with her church family. She loved all her nieces, nephews, great and great-great nieces and nephews very much, which now remember “Auntie Aud” very fondly.
