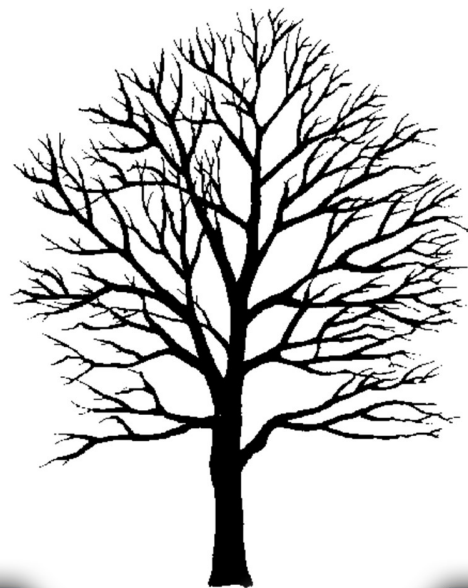


The Fallen Limb

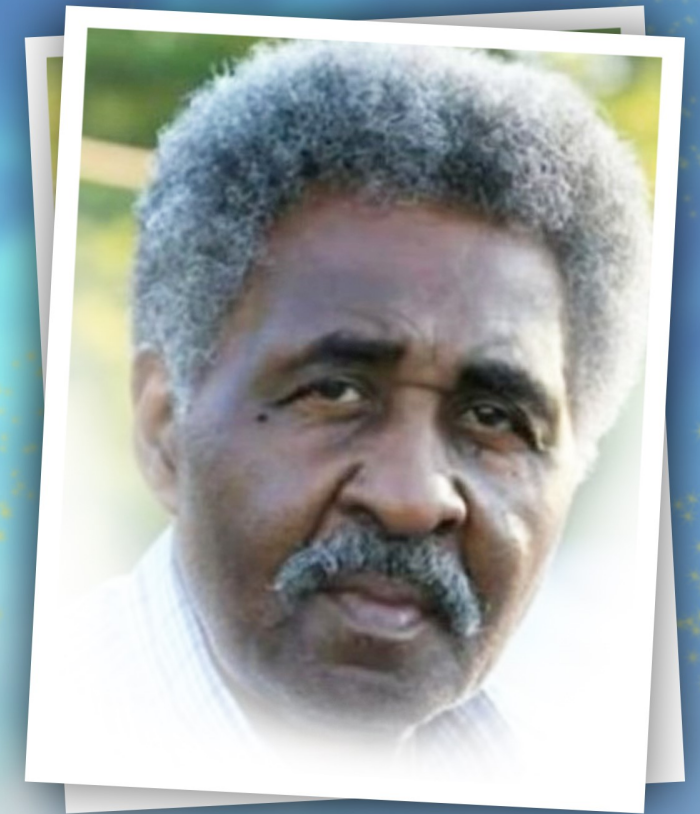
