Elder Carolyn Taylor Wilson “known as CT,” was born in Fitzgerald Ga on March 22, 1940 to the late Mr. & Mrs. David & Lillie Mae Taylor of Abba Ga. She was the loving wife of Mr. Willie Wilson, Jr. who preceded her in death in 1999. She departed this life October 26, 2018 at her home in Fitzgerald, Georgia.

At an early age she joined Kings Chapel Missionary Baptist Church of Abba Ga. She went through the Irwin County School System and graduated in 1958. She went on to pursue a career in cosmetology. She later worked as a nursing assistant and continued to earn her LPN license in nursing.
