Aug. 4, 1961 - Feb. 11, 2017

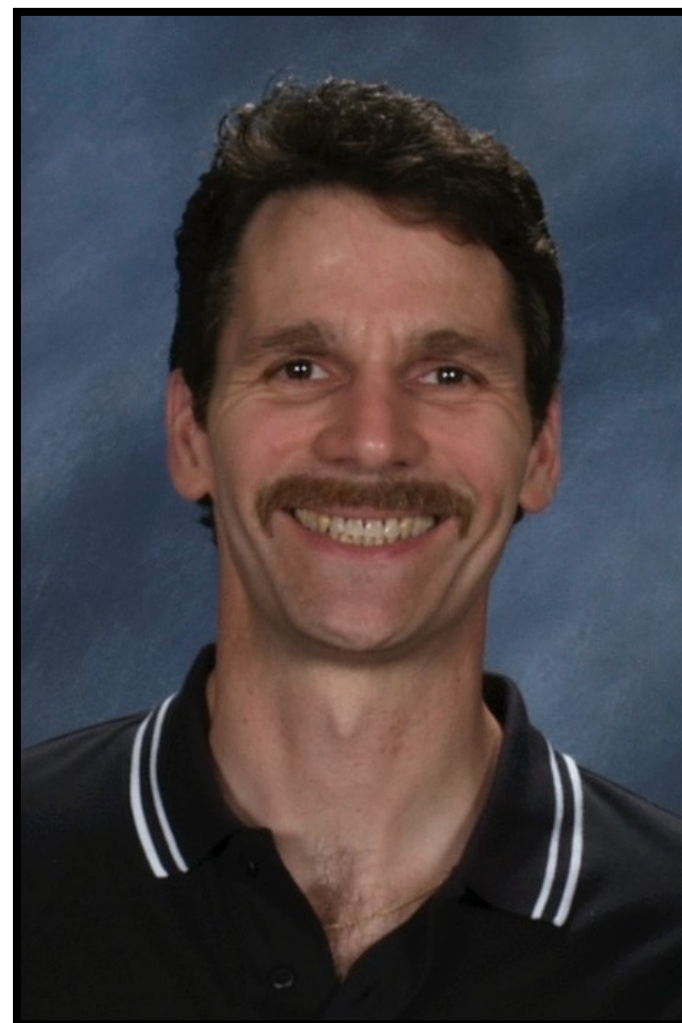
