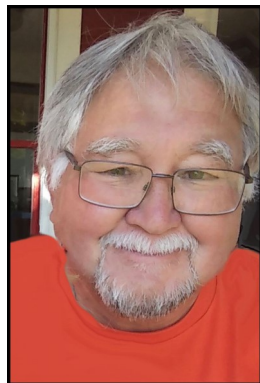


Lewis Floyd Hines Jr.
