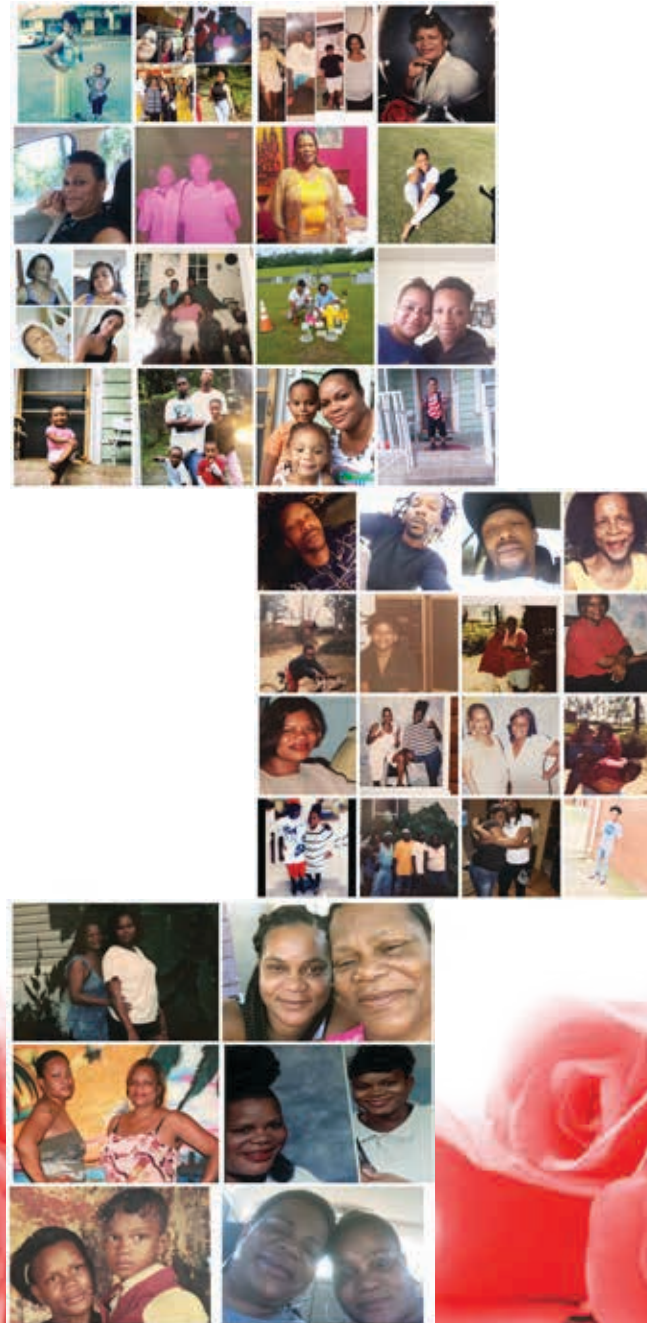


# Obituary
