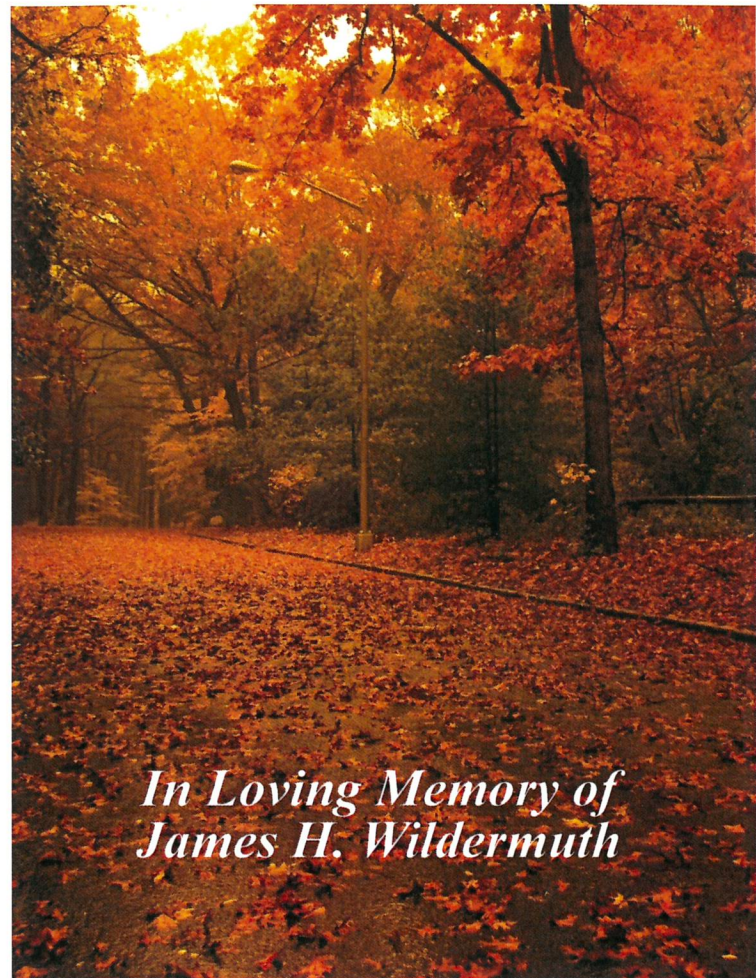


On behalf of the families we serve, we thank you
