

What I Know ...



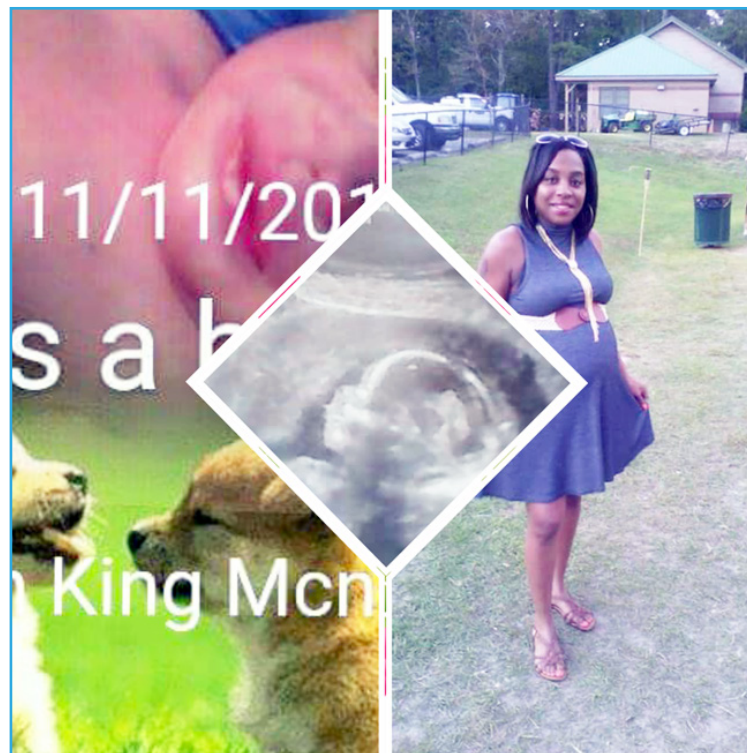
I know you soar with angels now
