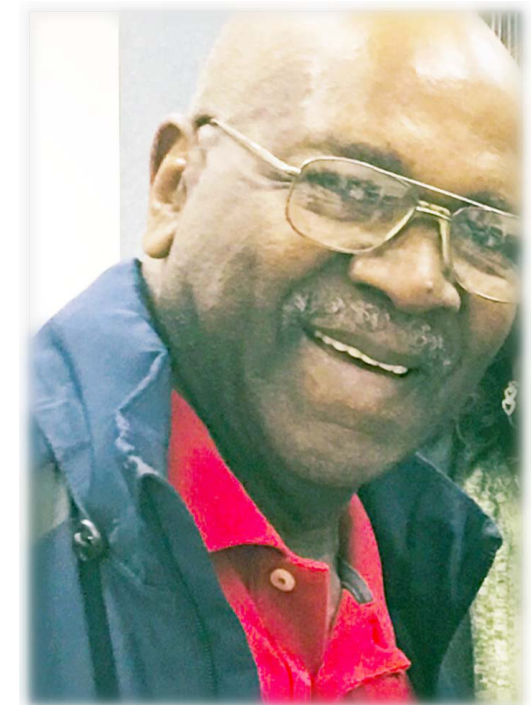

THE OBITUARY
