
## THE OBITUARY DR. MARY PATRICIA LONG

Dr. Mary Patricia Thomas Long, daughter of the late James Albert Thomas, Jr, and the late Mary Kemp Thomas, was born on April 25, 1948 in Raeford, N.C.

Dr. Long was affectionately known as Evangelist Long or Pat and a true believer in God and had a passion for Christian Education spreading the Word of God. She was a graduate of Upchurch High School and North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University, Greensboro, N.C. with a BS Degree in Business Education. She loved sporting her Aggie Pride!! After graduation she accepted a job with General Motors Acceptance Corporation (GMAC) in Washington, DC and later moved back home to Raeford, N.C. Upon returning to Raeford, she began work at the Hoke County Literacy Program; then taught with the Sandhills Community College Literacy Program and retired as a teacher from Fayetteville Technical Community College, Fayetteville, N.C. Because of her desire to study the word of God she followed in the footsteps of her mother and completed her Doctorate of Prophetic Ministry Southeastern Global Assembly for Apostolic Order School of Prophet, Raeford, NC. Pat was an active member of the Federation of Women's Clubs, Inc, an affiliate of the National Association of Colored Women's Club, Inc., the Nation's oldest Black organization and was a member of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP). She was a successful and proud Independent Mary Kay Consultant to the extent that while she was hospitalized; she was marketing and recruiting representatives in her business and selling products.

Pat professed Christ at an early age and joined St. Matthew Church of God Founded by Jesus Christ in Timberland, N.C. After moving to Washington, D.C., she joined Christian Tabernacle Church as a leader of the Christian Education Ministry. To continue her spiritual teachings, she joined the Wingate Community Church of God in Wingate, N.C. under the leadership and guidance of her mother, Dr. Mary K. Thomas and her father Deacon James A. Thomas, Jr. She remained a member of the Leadership Team under her Pastor, Elder Vincent J. Chambers, Sr, until her death. She initiated the Christian Education Ministry, the Women's Conference, and taught Sunday School Superintendents how to connect Sunday School with the mission of the church. She never wavered nor allowed the Word of God to be compromised. She wore many hats at Wingate and always believed that everything "Works in God's Own Time". As an inspirational leader in the Church of God Founded by Jesus Christ, she was the General Superintendent for all churches, Vice President of the Ministerial Alliance in the Southern District, a Trainer and Mentor to many. Everyone just loved listening to her teachings and what she had to say.

Left to cherish her memories is her only son, Cedric Antonio Long of Raeford, N.C.; one grandson, Delonta Hammond; three great-grandchildren; Demon Hammond, Treasure Hammond, and Carter Hammond; one sister, Jane Thomas Smith (Lynwood) of Durham, N.C.; one brother, Vernice Lee Thomas (Linda) of Greensboro, N.C. and a host of nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles and family members and friends who will cherish her memory.
