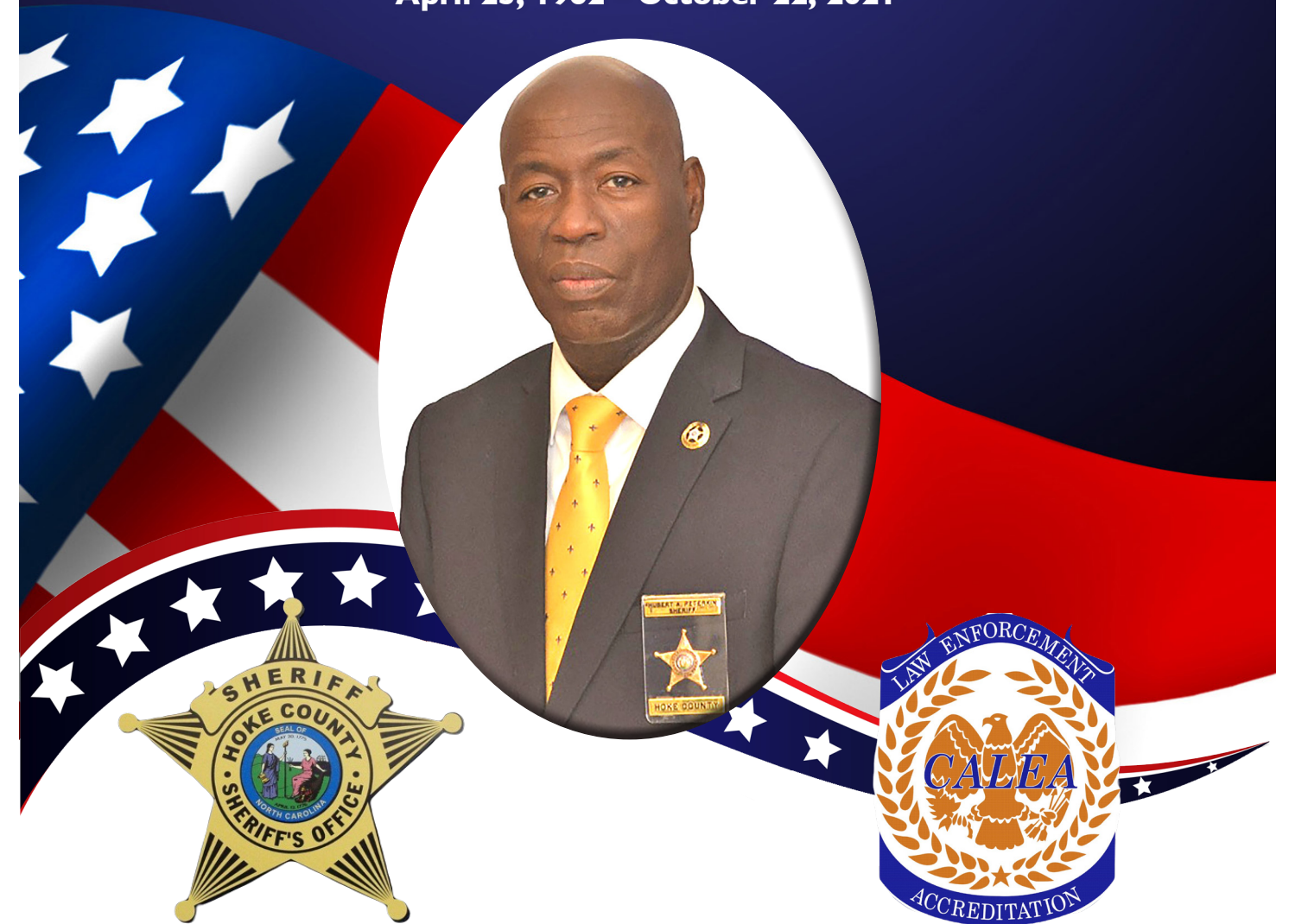

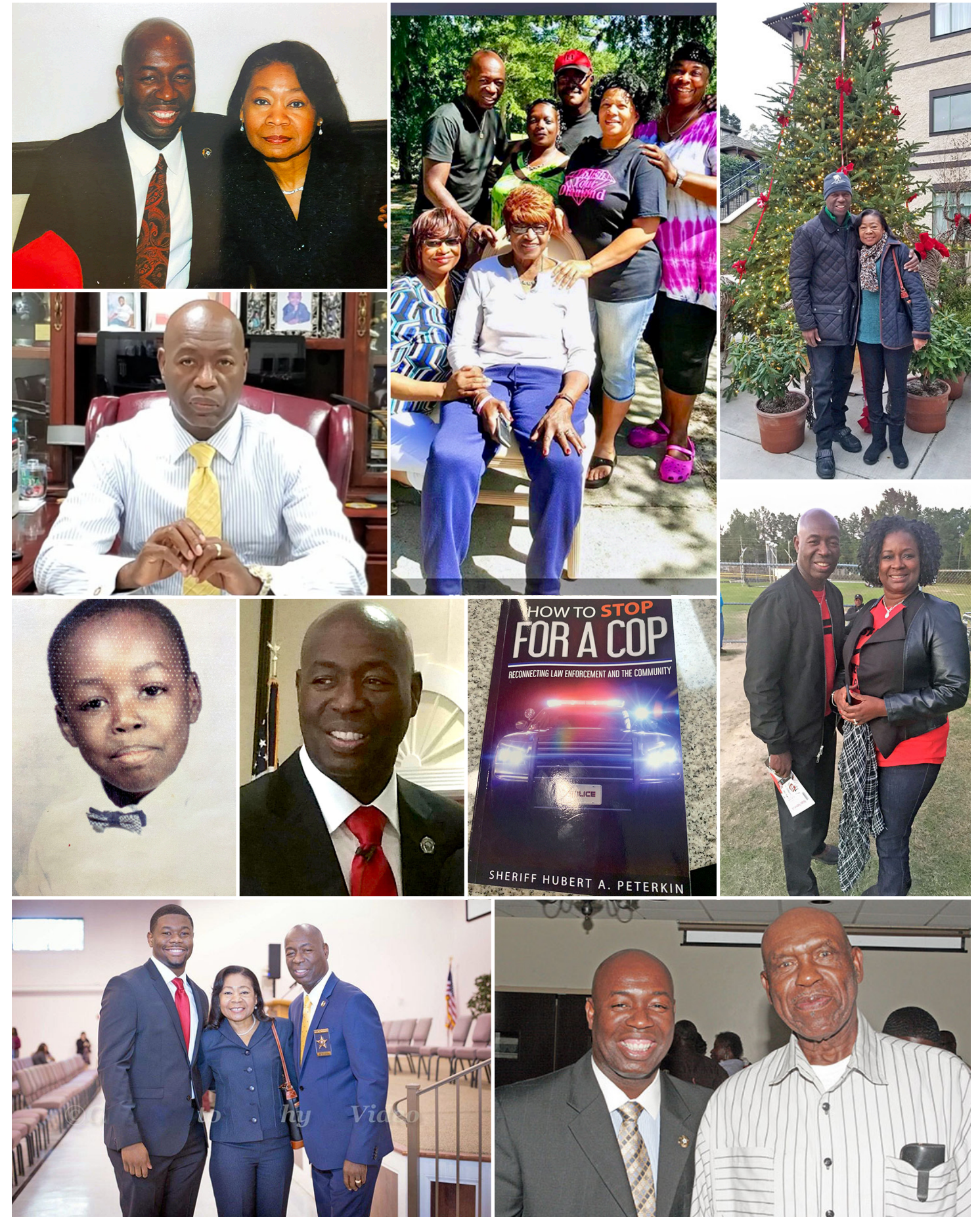

Obituary

DR. HUBERT ANTHONY PETERKIN was born in Brooklyn, New York on April 25, 1962 to the late Hubert and Onnie Peterkin. A 1981 graduate of Hoke County High School. Hubert is survived by his loving wife Della, three children: Antisha Peterkin, LaSwanda Peterkin and Antonio Peterkin. He has five siblings: Mary Bratcher, Sim Peterkin (Connie), Sharon Bowden (Franklin), Dennis Peterkin (Darlene) and Darryl Smith (Lomonica). Two sister-in-laws: Rose Mitchell and Carolyn Monroe and one brother-in-law, Aaron Monroe. Adored by his only grandchild, Ezra Peterkin; nieces and nephews: Ratisha Peterkin, Laparish Peterkin, Erica Dixon, Sim Peterkin II, Brianna Peterkin, April Lynn Stubbs, Aaron Lide Jr., Shannon Lide, Cameron Lide, and Deona Peterkin; three aunts: Celia Tomlin, Jessie McPhaul and Catherine Peterkin and host of other relatives and friends.

DR. HUBERT ANTHONY PETERKIN is a lifelong resident of Hoke County. He has been actively involved in the city of Raeford and Hoke County since his teenage years as a servant in his church, volunteer, singer, and author. He has been in Law Enforcement for over 30 years and served as an officer with the Fayetteville Police Department, holding various positions for a total of 16 years. In 1998, he was appointed as the Chief Deputy of the Hoke County Sheriff’s Office. Hubert was first elected Sheriff of Hoke County in 2002, second term in 2006, third term in 2010, and ran unopposed in his fourth term 2014 and re-elected in for a 5th term in 2018. He has received an Advanced Certification from the N.C. Sheriff’s Education and Training Standards Commission and an Advanced Certification from the N.C. Criminal Justice Education and Training Commission. Sheriff Peterkin also served as President for the North Carolina Sheriff’s Association in 2015 and as the Chairman of the North Carolina Sheriff’s Association’s Executive Board from 2016-2018.

Under Sheriff Peterkin’s leadership, the Hoke County Sheriff’s Office has become a Nationally Accredited Agency. In addition to this, a newly constructed Detention Center (Jail) was built and a newly renovated Sheriff’s Office was constructed. Many significant changes have been made to enhance the performance of the Sheriff’s Office staff and to ensure the safety of Hoke County Citizens.

Dr. Peterkin earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business and Government from Liberty University. He continued to advance his education by attending the University of Phoenix earning a Master’s in Public Administration and a Doctoral Degree in Management. Sheriff Peterkin is a decorated officer and has received numerous awards.
