THE OBITUARY

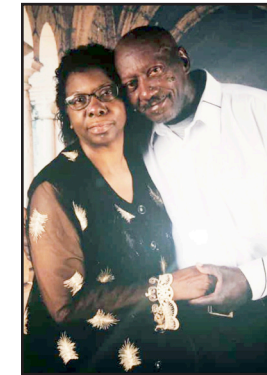
