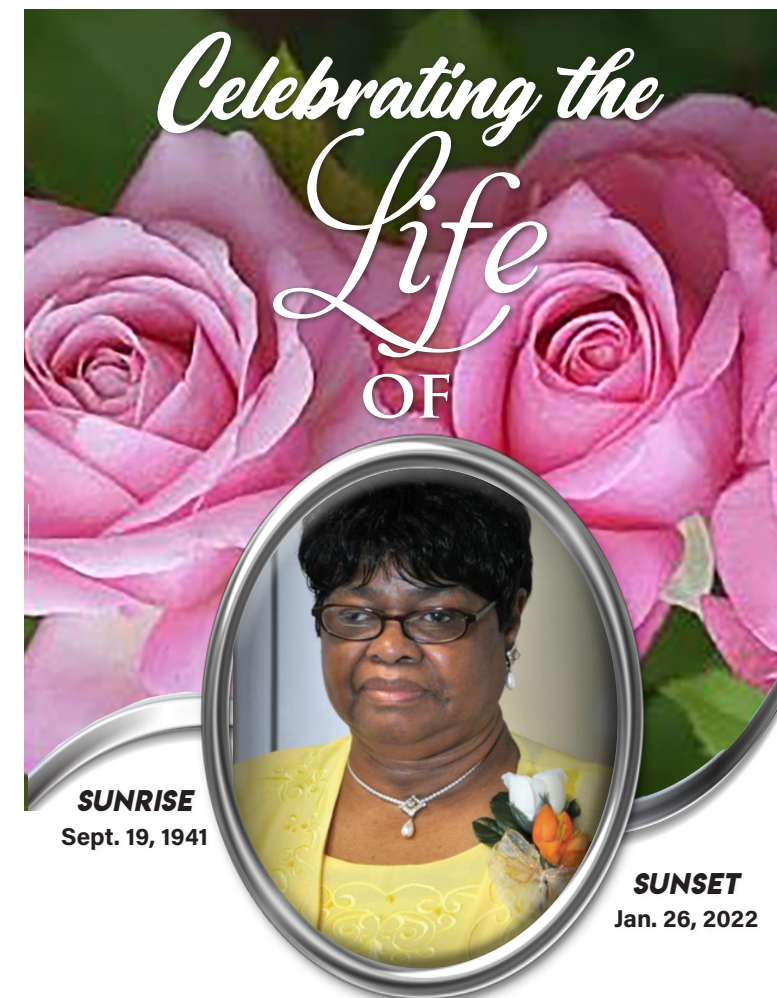

QUEEN accepted Christ as her personal Savior early in life and joined Shady Grove Missionary Baptist Church of Raeford, NC.

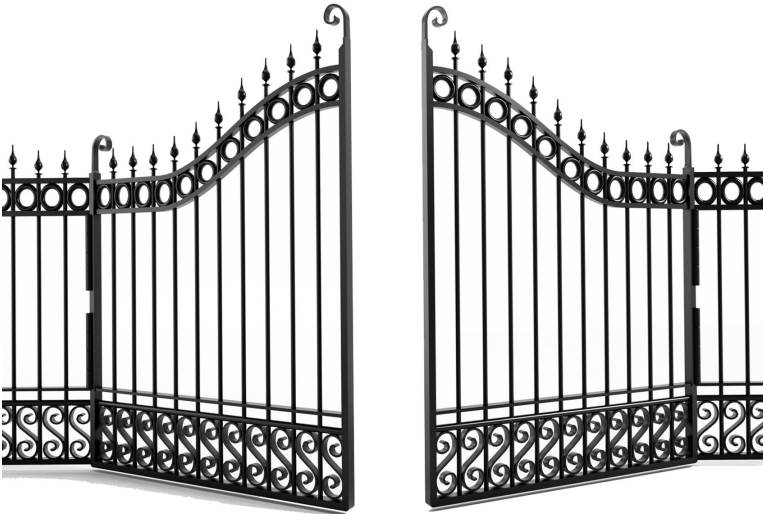
She attended Robeson County schools. Queen was employed at The House of Raeford for a number of years until her health failed.
