# JANAZAH ISLAMIC BURIAL PRAYER

The Muslim Funeral Prayer (Janaza) is the last rite of the deceased. It is prayed for Muslims by Muslims. The deceased is placed in front of the Imam and the believers stand behind the Imam. The prayer is conducted with 4 takbirs.

**First Takbir:** Allahu Akbar - In the Name of Allah, the Most Gracious, The Most Merciful. All praise is due to Allah, Lord of the worlds. The Most Gracious, The Most Merciful, Most of the Day of Judgement. It is You we worship and You we ask for help. Guide us to the straight path, the path of those upon who You have given favor, not of those who have evoked Your anger or of those who are astray.

Second Takbir: Allahu Akbar - "Oh Allah, shower Your Mercy upon Muhammad and the followers of Muhammad as You showered Your Mercy upon Abraham and the followers of Abraham. Behold, You are Praiseworthy, Glorious. Oh Allah, shower your Blessings upon Muhammad and the followers of Muhammad as You showered Your Blessings upon Ibrahim and the followers of Ibrahim. Behold, You are Praiseworthy, Glorious.

**Third Takbir:** Allahu Akbar - Oh Allah, forgive those of us that are alive and those of us that are dead, those of us that are present and those of us who are absent; our minors and our elders. Oh Allah, whomsoever of us you keep alive, let him live as a follower of Islam and whomsoever of us you cause to die, let him die as a believer.

Fourth Takbir: Allahu Akbar - Oh Allah, do not deny the reward which is due her, do not expose us to temptation after her death. Forgive us and her. As salaamu alaikum wa Rahmatullah – Peace and Mercy of Allah be upon you
