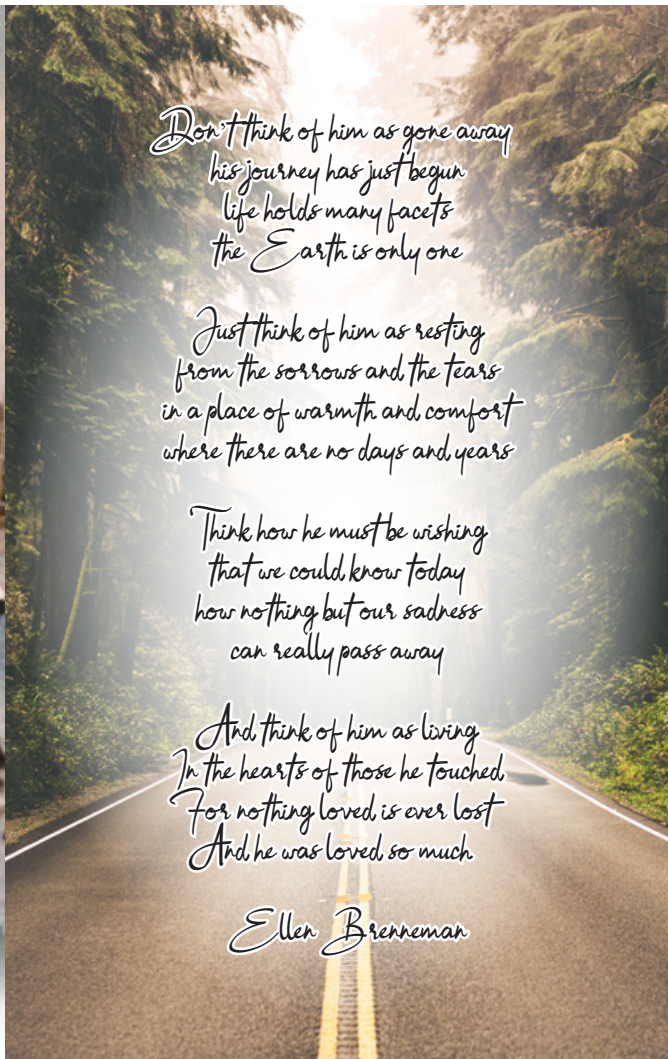




*Eternal rest grant unto your servant Hector,

Ettore, known as Hector, was born in Torrevecchia, Chieti, Italy. Hector married his loving wife Rosanna on June 20, 1965.

In March of 1966, Hector and Rosanna started their journey from Italy to Canada by boat to Halifax, Nova Scotia then onward to Calgary.

Hector was always passionate about sports, from his earlier years where he played soccer to his ongoing love of watching anything hockey, football, soccer, and wrestling related. He also enjoyed spending time on cars - including motorbikes, going fishing, and playing bocce. He was a perfectionist at everything he attempted, he always caught the most fish and always won at pool or foosball. Hector was never happier than when he had a new pet in the house, from dogs to birds and cats, usually all rescued from the SPCA. Above all, he enjoyed spending time with his family.
