

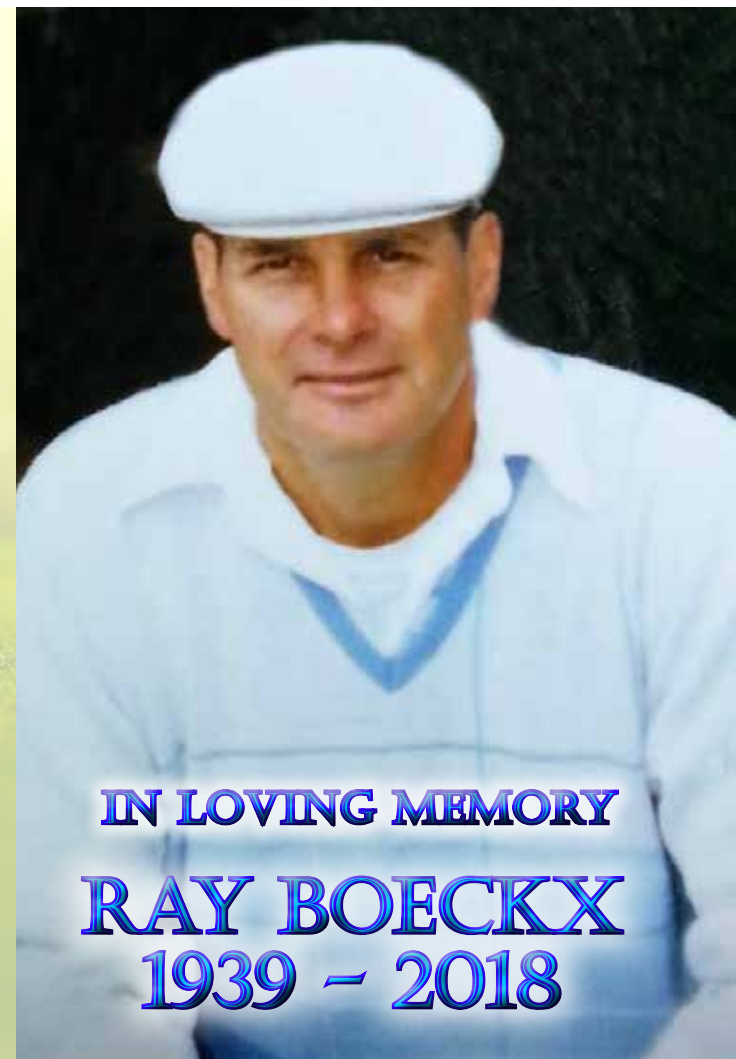


The Broken Chain

RAY BOECKX MAY 24, 1939 – MARCH 23, 2018
