We couldn't make you stay.*

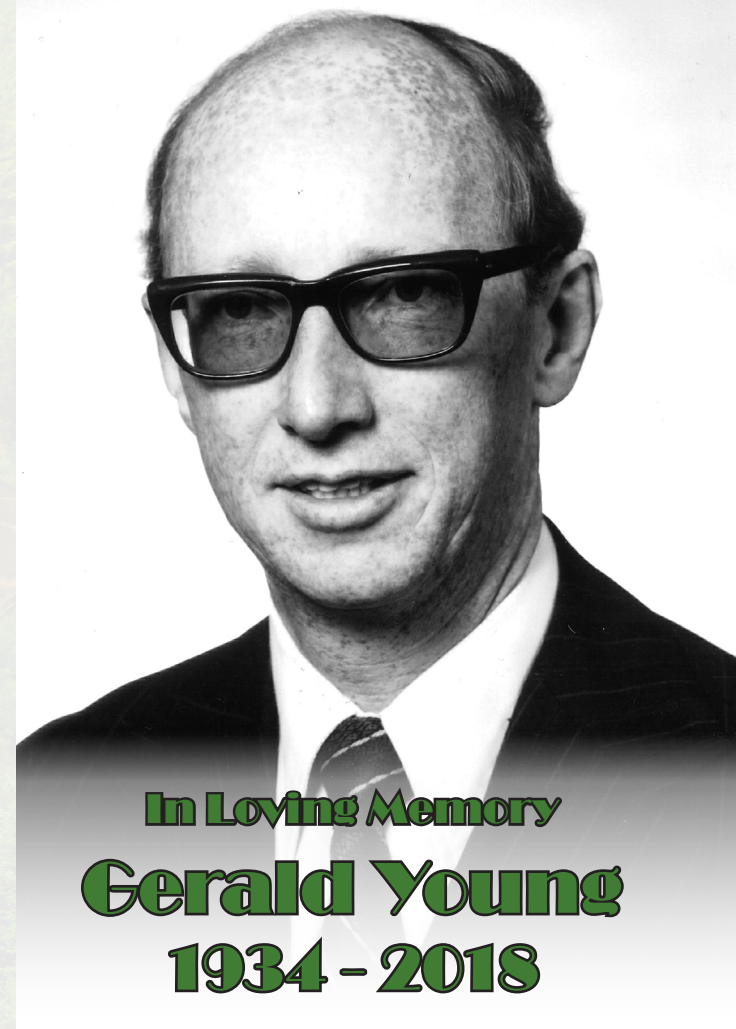
