After she graduated, she relocated to Portland where she gained employment with Portland Public Schools. She retired from that school district after 34 years of dedicated service.

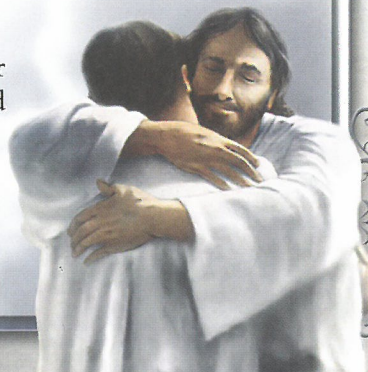
She was an active member of Alpha Kappa Alpha (AKA) Sorority, Inc. since her college days.
