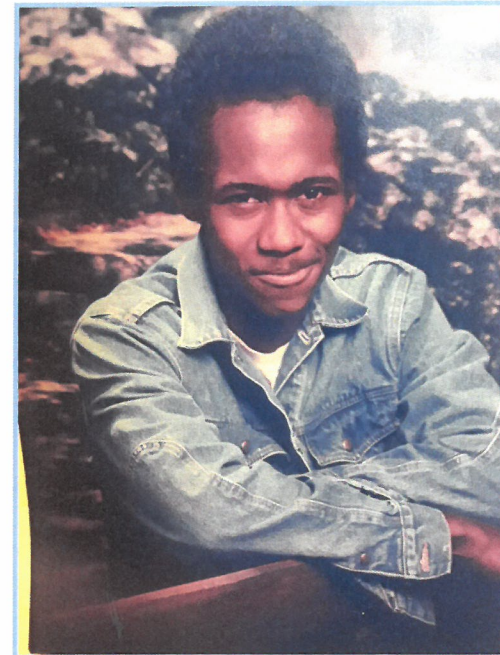
Your love extends beyond the sun & the moon
