27 grandchildren, 17 great-grandchildren, aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, and a host of extended family and friends.

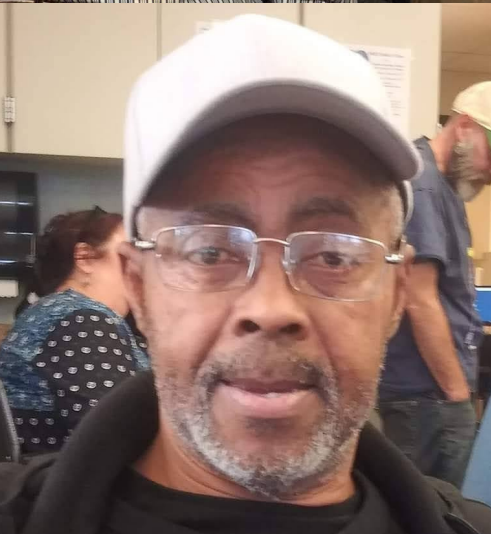












PRAYER FOR MY DAD
