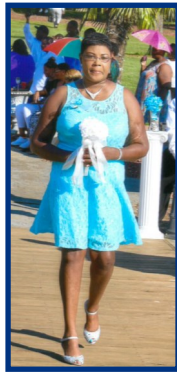
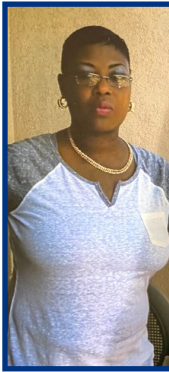


Poem

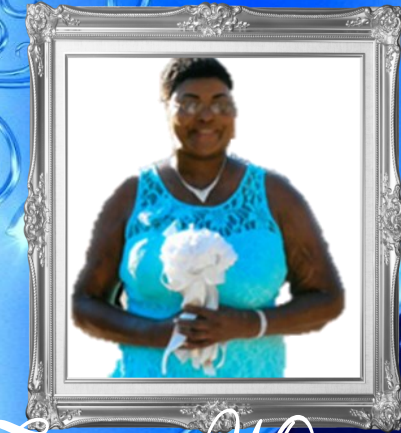
