"I'm Free"

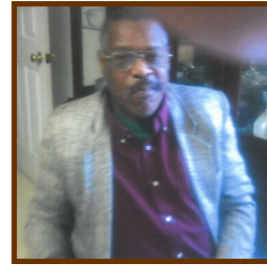
Don't grieve for me for now I'm free.
