I gave you my love, you can only guess How much you gave to me in happiness. I thank you for the love you have shown But now it's time I travel on alone.


So grieve awhile for me, if grieve you must Then let your grief be comforted by trust. It's only for a little while that we must part, So bless the memories within your heart.

And if you listen with your heart you'll hear


