Through his journey of life Lezarian has met several prominent individuals: RJ Reynolds of the Dramatics, Judge Greg Mathis, and several other prominent Detroiters.

Lezarian was lively and fun-loving. He worked as a waiter at various restaurants in and around the Detroit Area and he never met a stranger. He enjoyed eating, spending time with family, friends, and dancing. Whenever there was a gathering, he was the life-of-the party.

Lezarian departed this earthly life on August 31, 2022. He will be missed by all who knew him. Lezarian was a joy to his mother Joyce, father, Ralph, sisters Shardai and Bernice, brother TooShort and a host of family and friends. 
































### Expressions of Love to Lezarian
