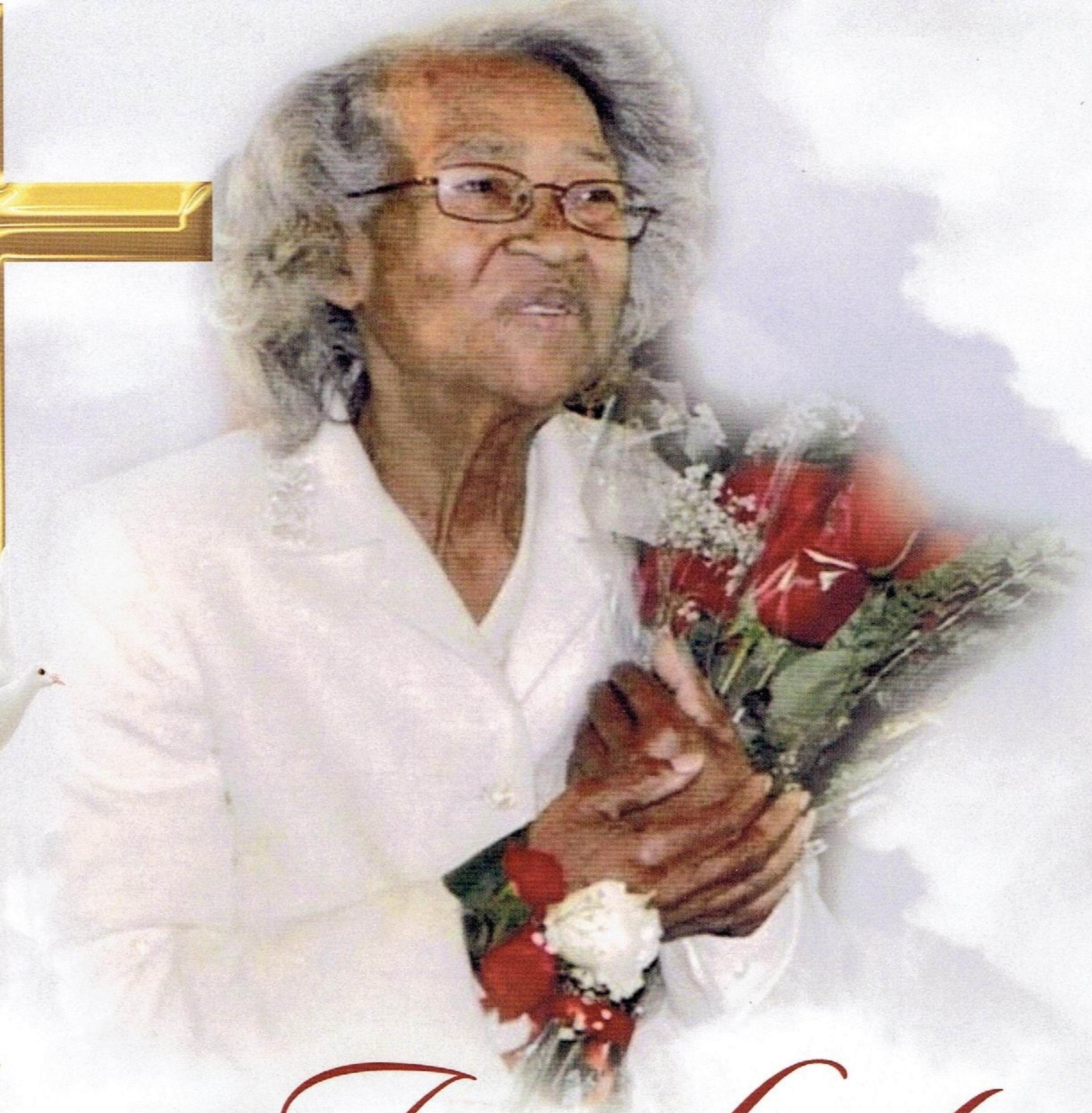

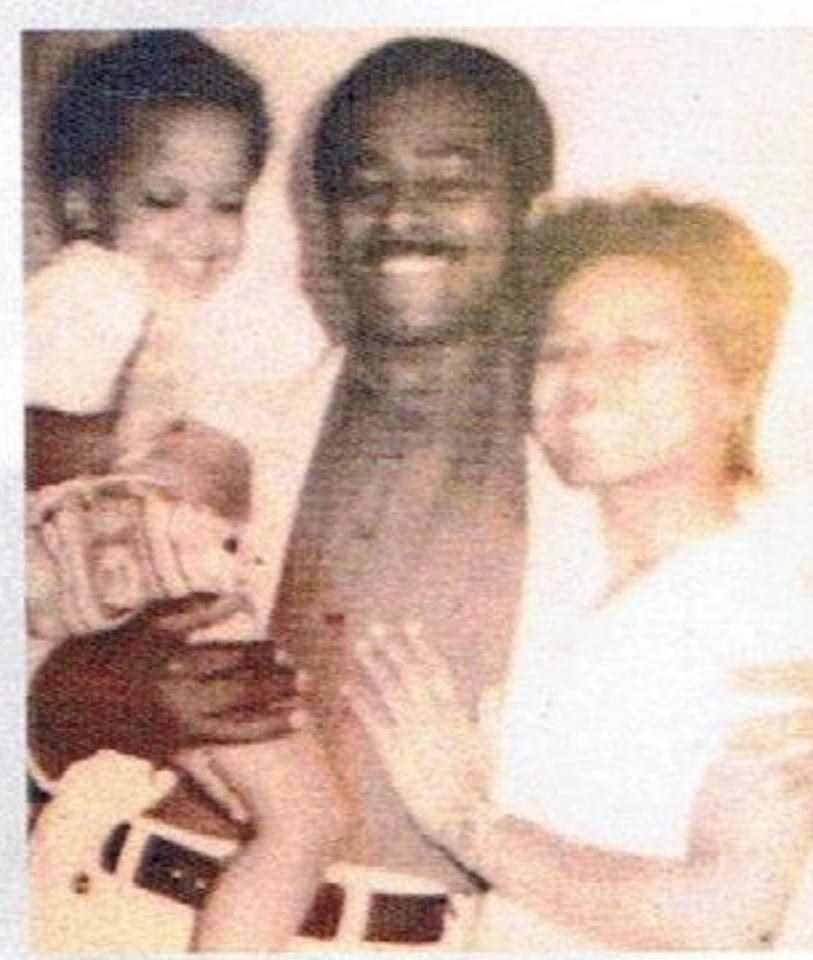
The Obituary

Doris Jean London (nee Thomas) was born on September 22, 1928 in Luxora, Arkansas to Leondus and Daniel Thomas. Doris married Floyd London on October 30, 1947 and relocated to Detroit, Michigan, where they would raise their loving children. Doris was a devoted Christian who kept God first in her life. She was an active and beloved member of Deeper Life Gospel Center where the congregation affectionately referred to her as "Mother London."

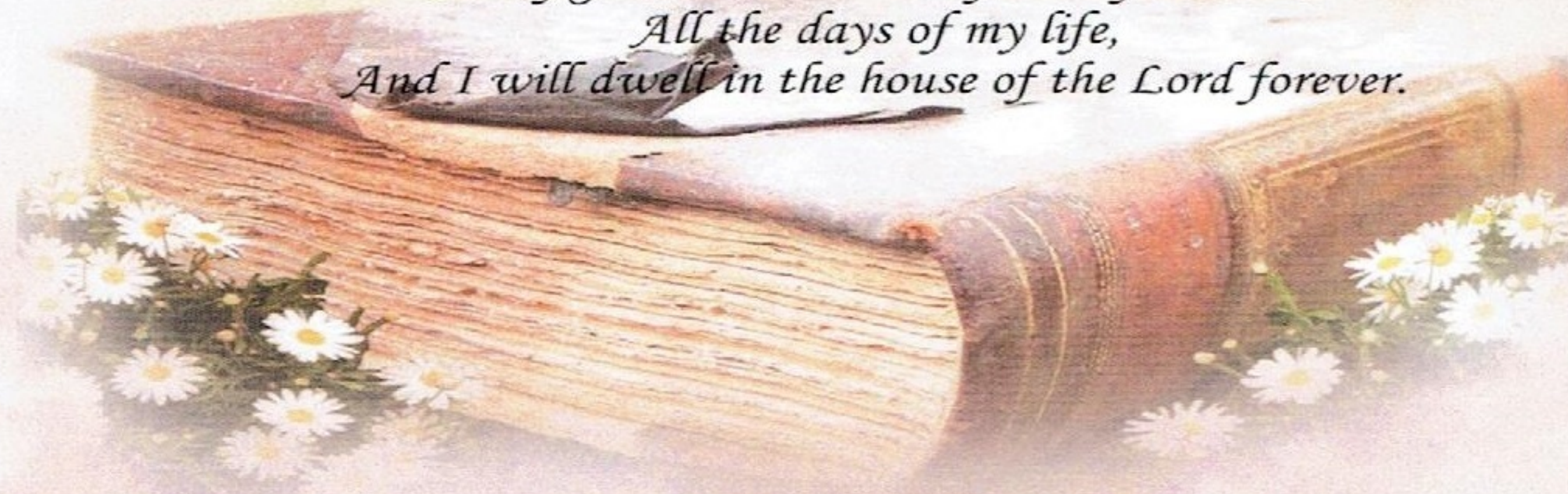


The 23rd Psalm
