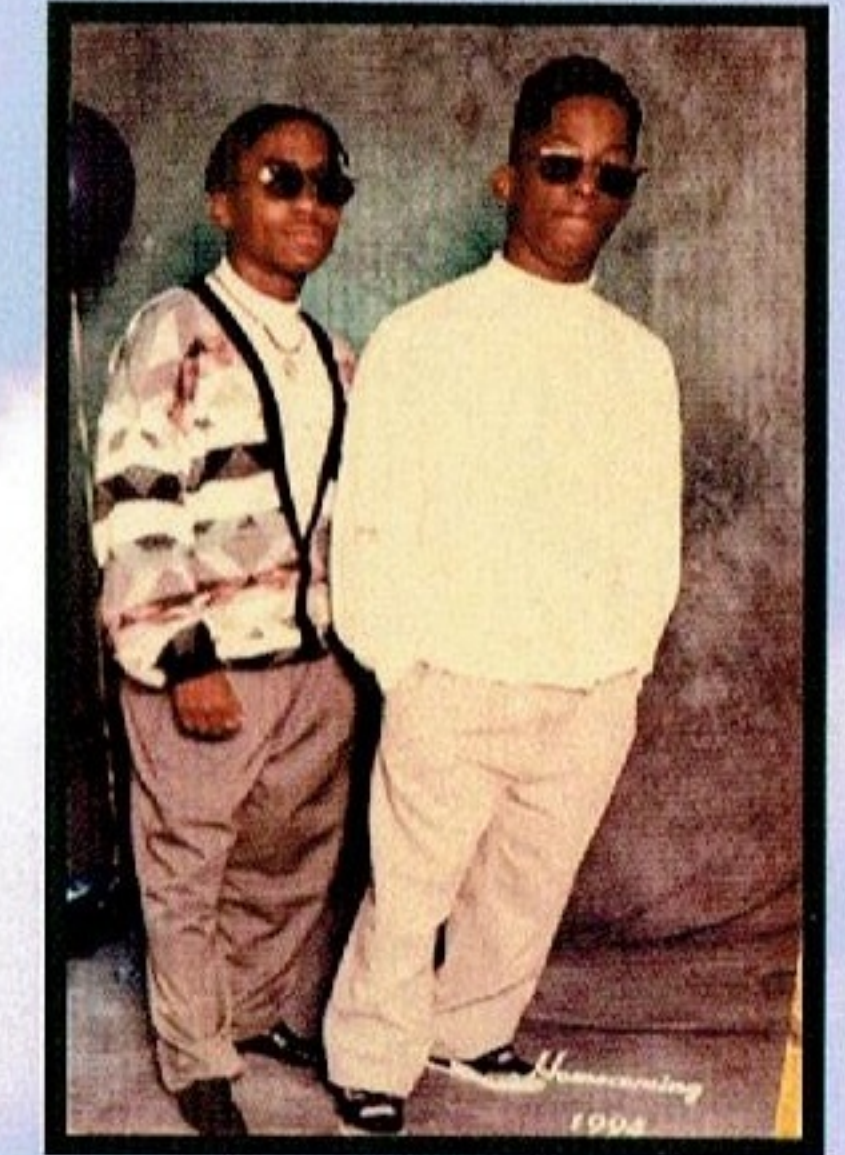
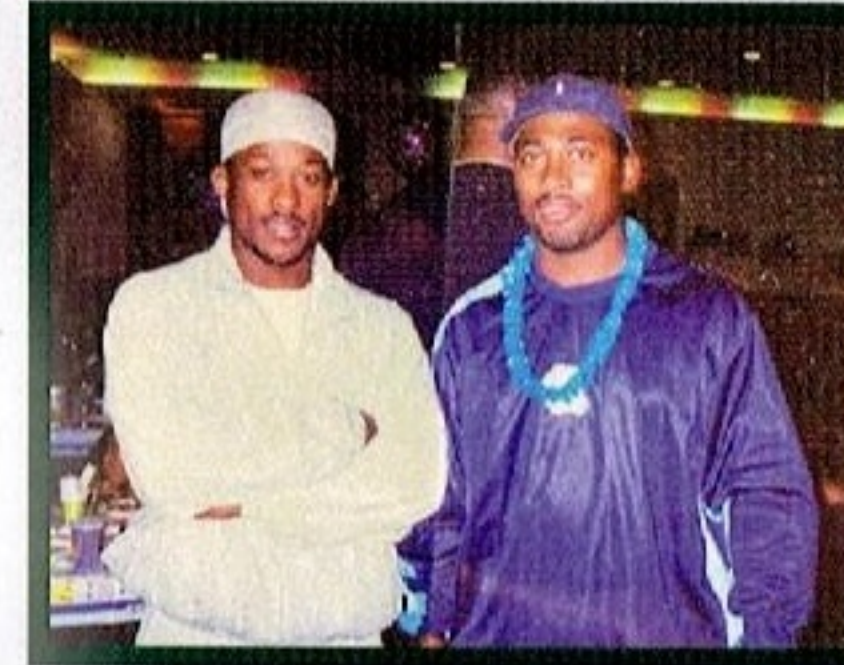


A HOLE IN OUR HEARTS

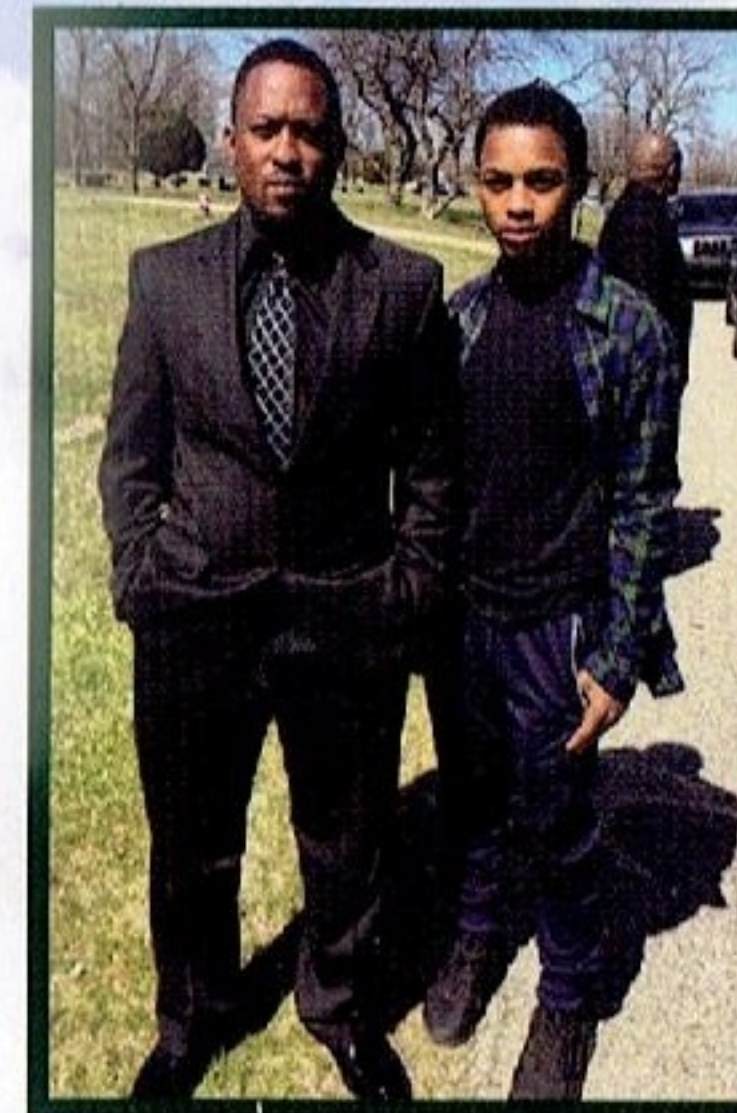
Something will remind me
