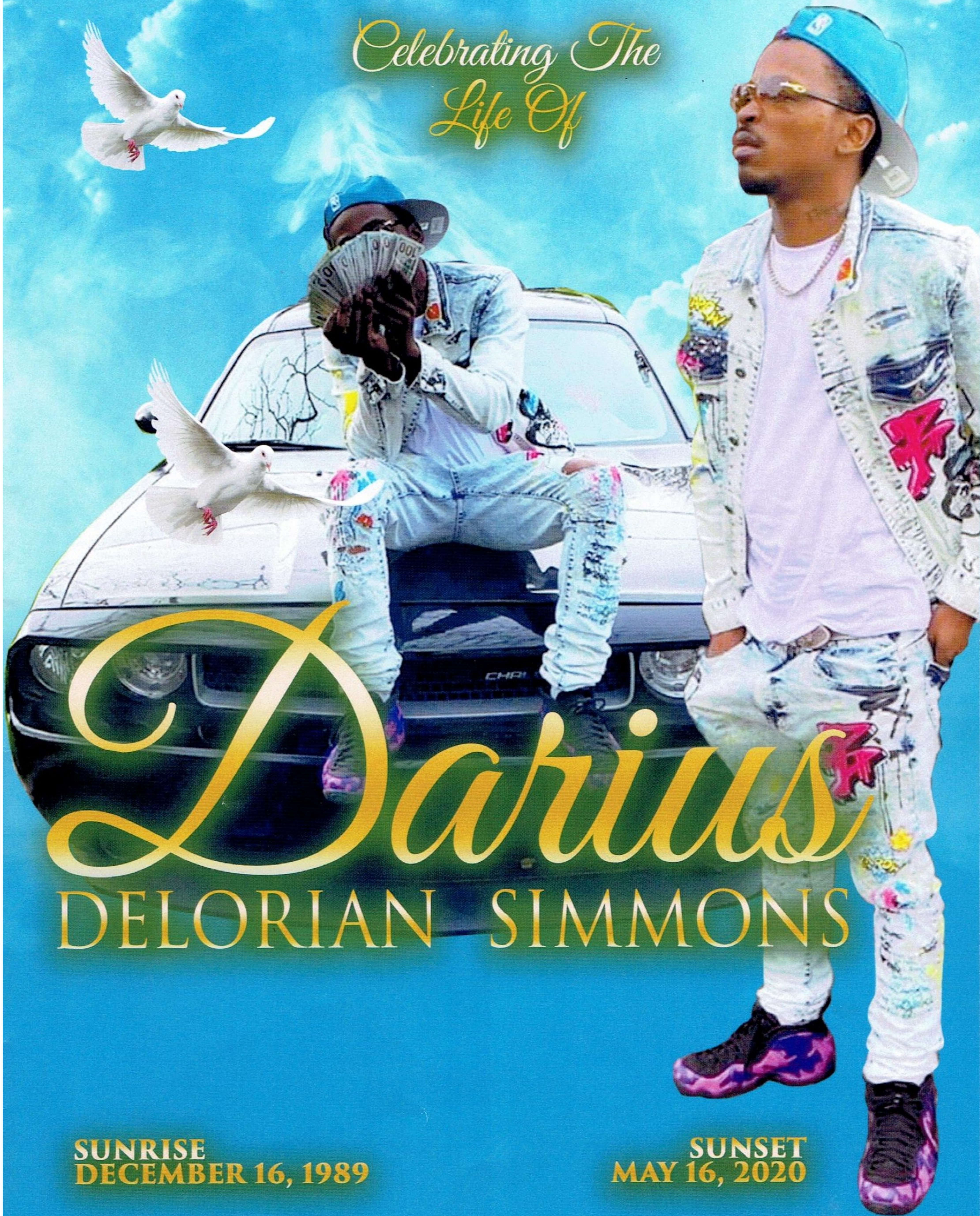

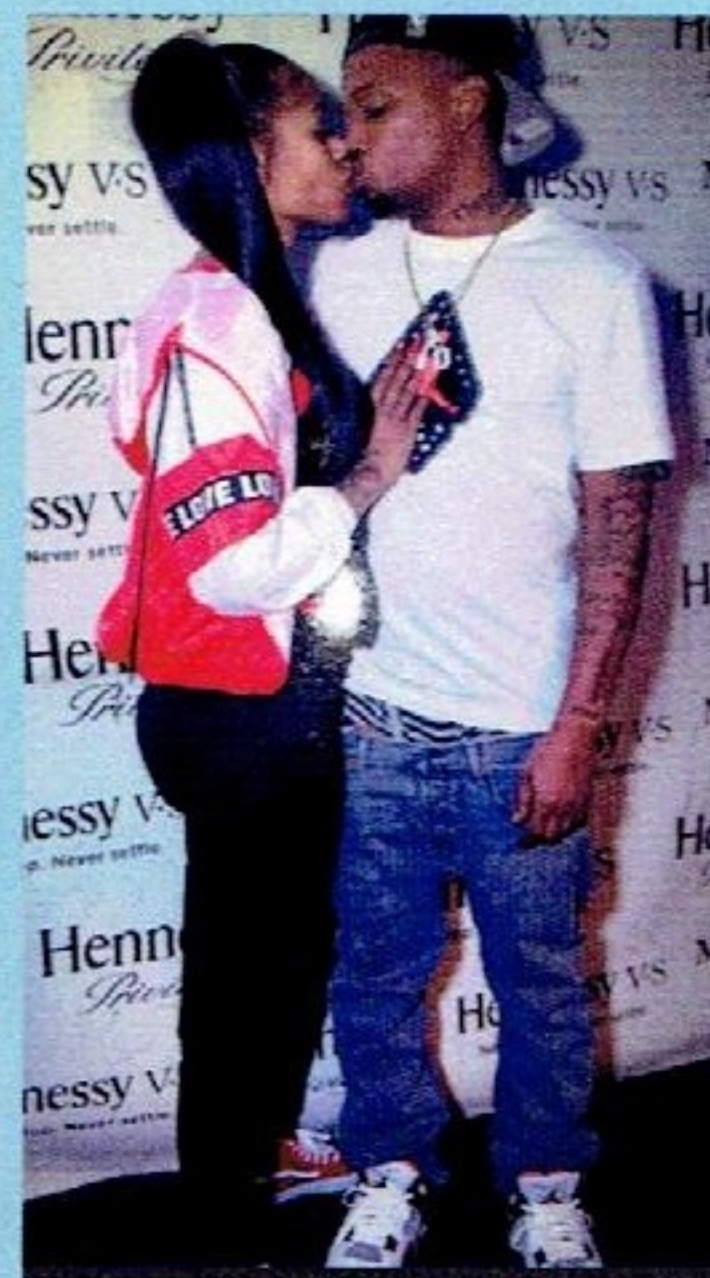

My life's been full, I've savored much,

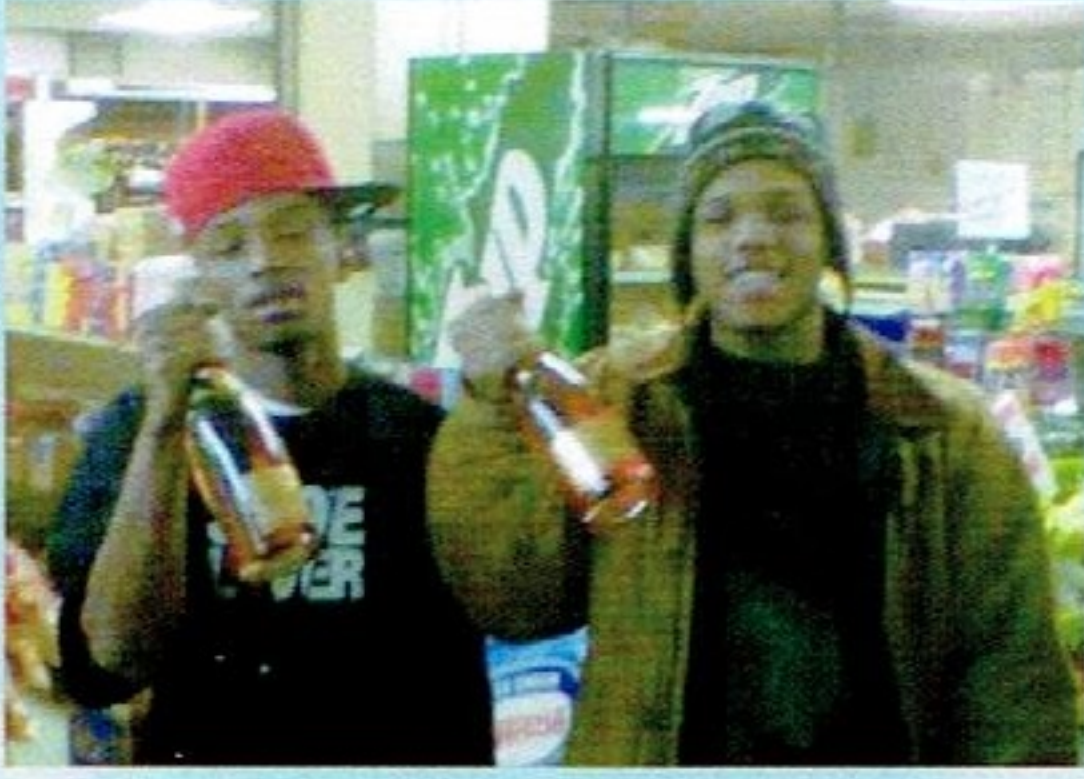
Good family, good times, a loved one's touch.
