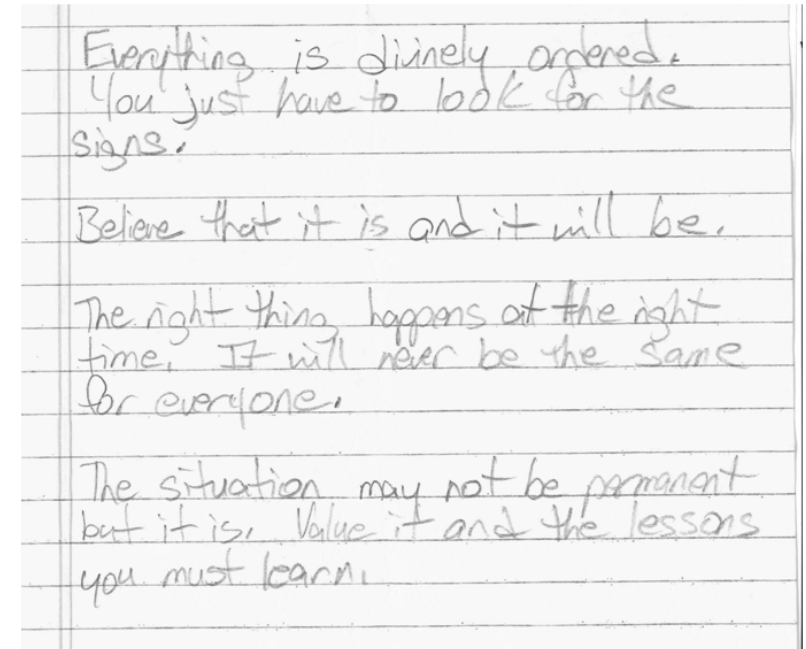
On March 3, 1974 an angel was born to Martha A. Hayes and Otis Smith Jr., and we named her Stacy Latrice Hayes.
