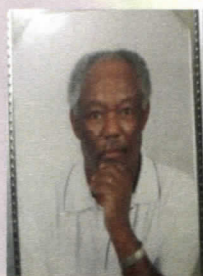


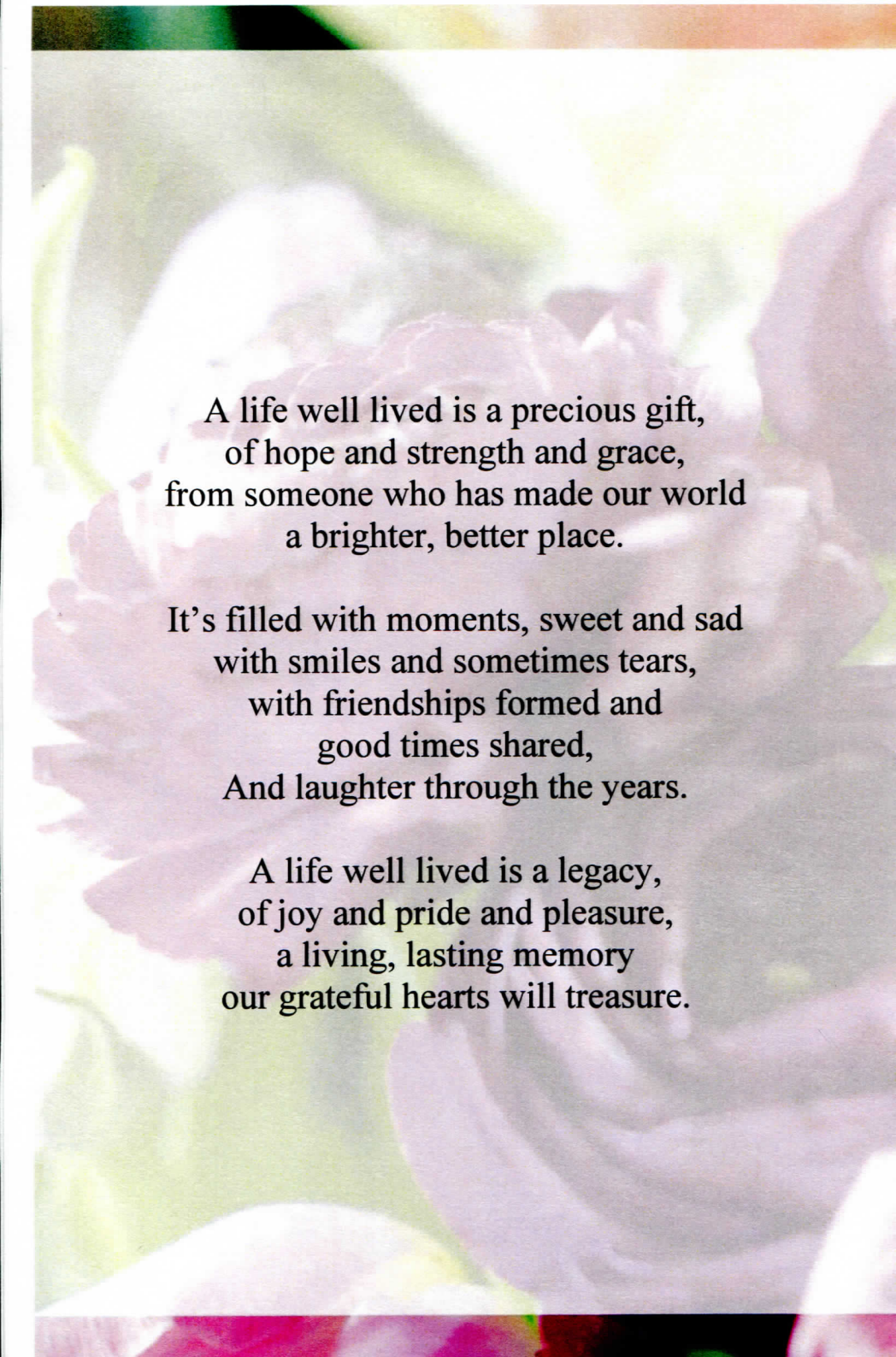
Obituary

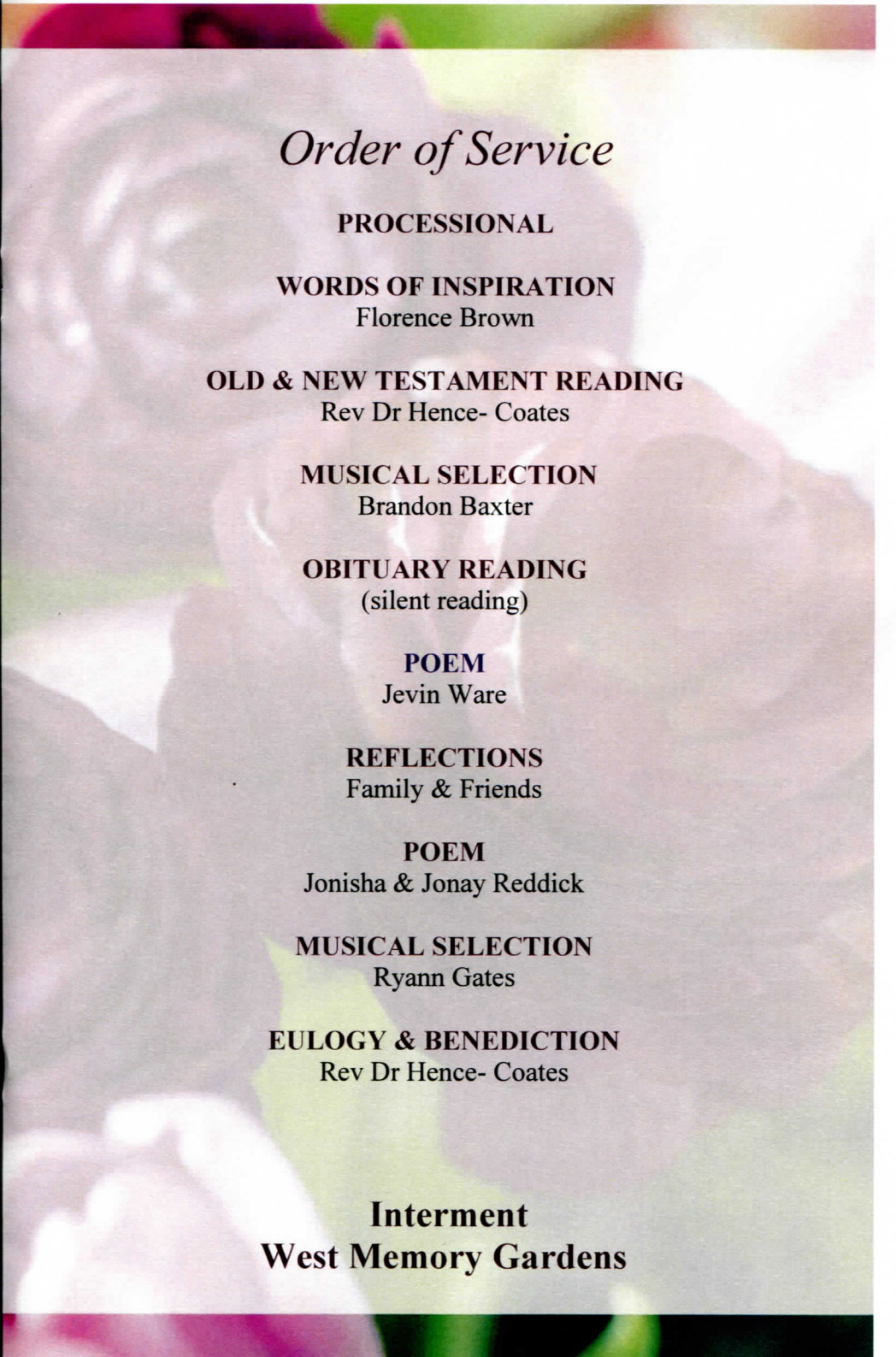




A life well lived is a precious gift,
