On Friday November 30th, 2018, Viola was called to her eternal home.

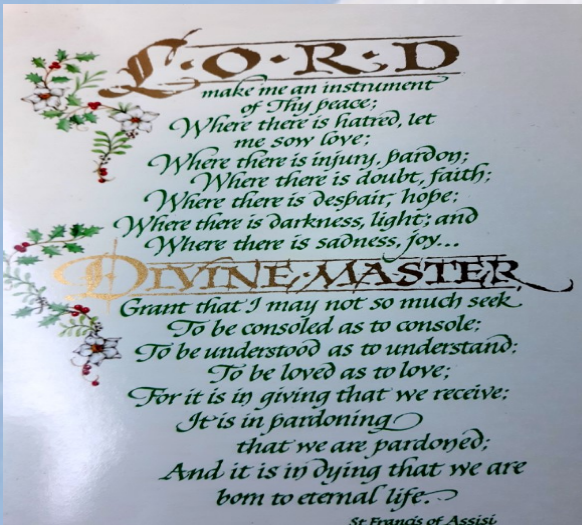
She is preceded in death by her parents, Mary King and Eddie Seabrooks; daughter Venecia Seabrooks.
