Her husband the Rev. Paul King accepted an associate pastoral position at the Mt. Pleasant Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Luther C. Daniels. Vera moved her membership to the Mt. Pleasant Baptist Church and joined the "Voices of Praise Choir" under the music direction of Brenda Robertson. She was a faithful member of the Mt. Pleasant Baptist Church under the new leadership Rev. Dwayne Simmons until her health declined.

Vera was a loving mother, grand, and great grandmother. She loved the Lord with all of her heart and gave him praise even when she was wheelchair bound. Everyone that metVera enjoyed her pleasant personality. She had a beautiful smile and contagious laugh.
