Don't cry for me

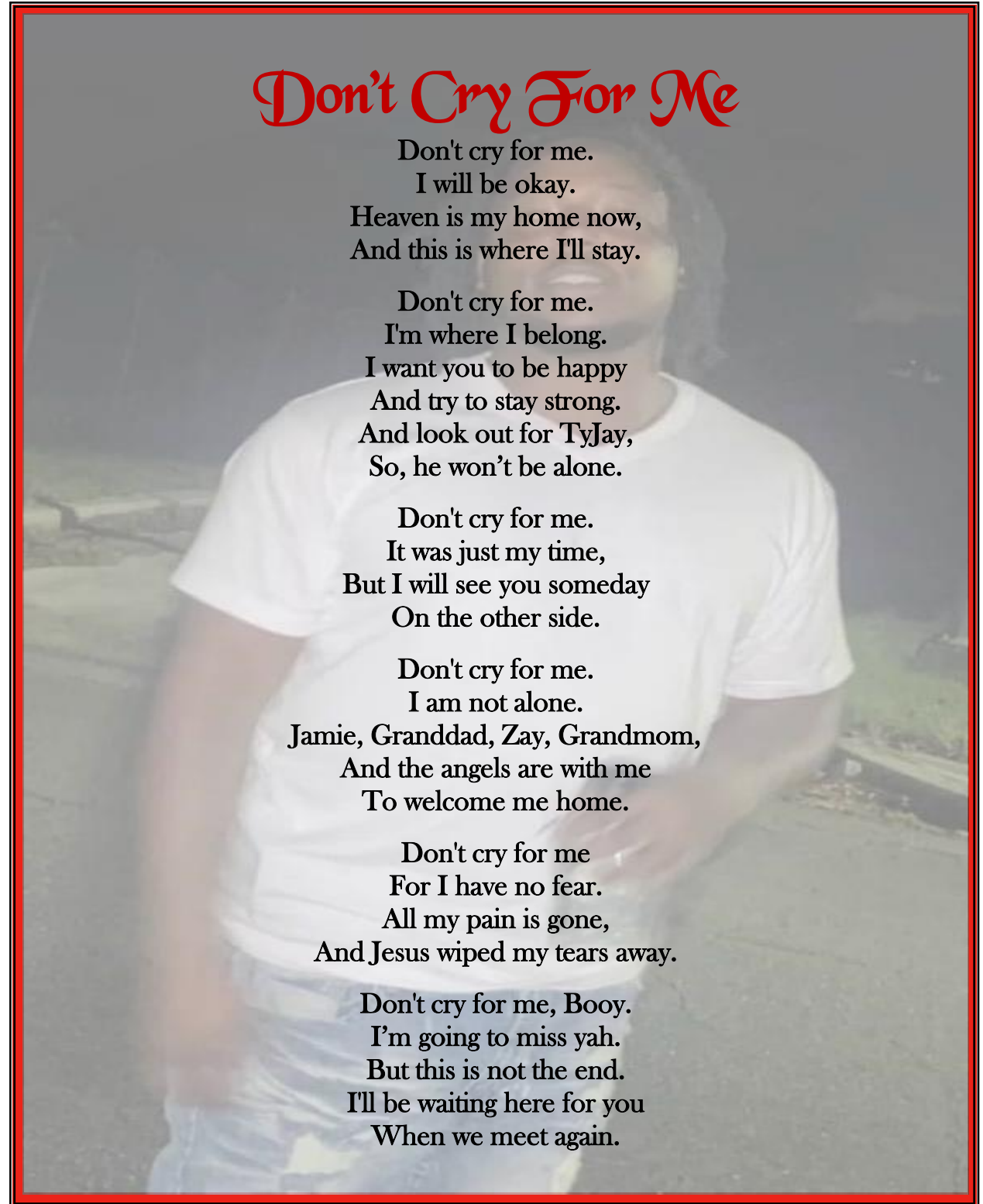
For I have no fear.
