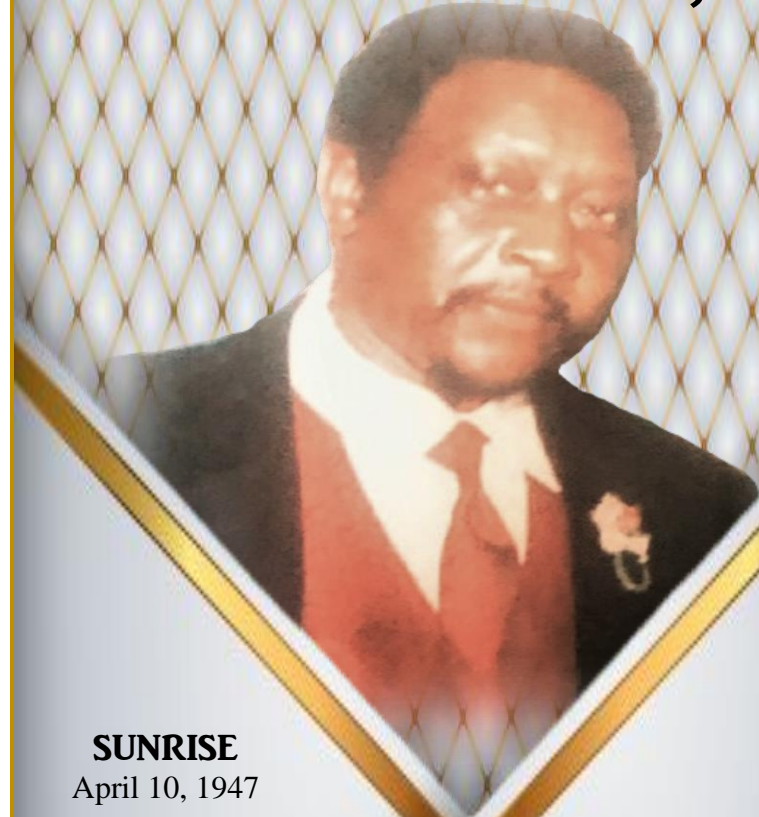

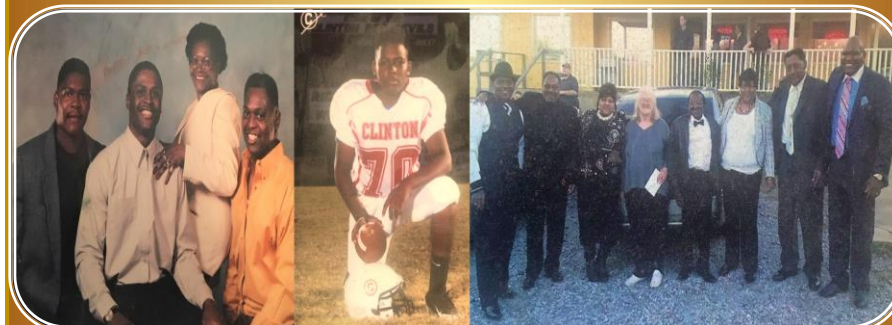
He was educated in the public schools of Newberry County, South Carolina.
