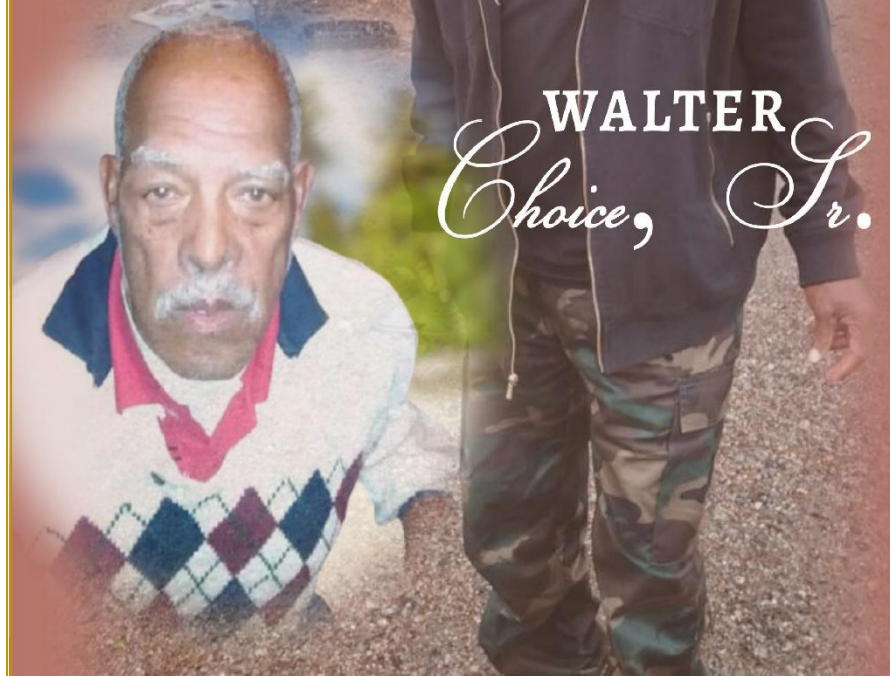

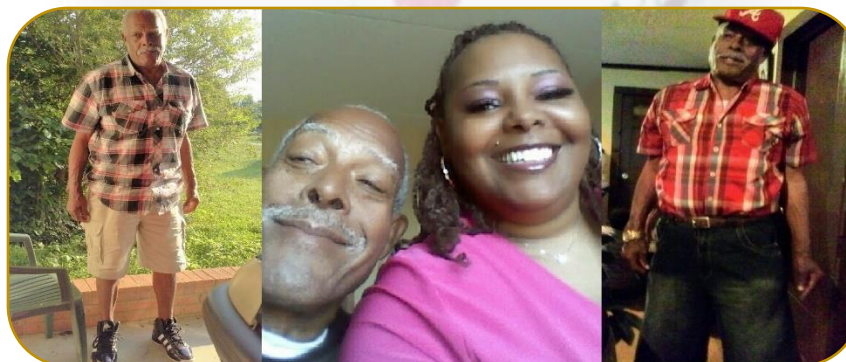
For many years, Walter was employed in Maintenance for the South Carolina Regional Housing Authority in Laurens, South Carolina.
