# Pastor William Jones, Sr.

**Pastor William Jones, Sr.** was called home to glory to rest in the Lord on April 6, 2018. He preached the gospel and maintained his ministry for nearly 50 years. He was devoted to his family, churches, friends, the community; and above all – to God.

Pastor Jones was born on October 30, 1936 to the late Reverend Devine Jones, Sr. and the late Henrietta Matthews-Jones of Grenada, MS; who preceded him in death. He confessed hope in Christ at a young age at the Jackson Chapel Missionary Baptist Church where he was a devoted member primarily under the leadership of the late Pastor James W. Brock and most recently under Pastor Tommy Goodwin. He accepted the call to ministry and was ordained in 1969. Early in his ministry, he pastored McClendon Grove Missionary Baptist Church (Highpoint community in Tallahatchie County, MS) and Saint Andrews Missionary Baptist Church (Holcomb, MS). He also pastored Union Grove Missionary Baptist Church from 1973 until he retired his pastorship in 2015. He was succeeded at Union Grove by Pastor Carl Ray. After retiring his pastorship, he ministered to the inmates at the local jail in Grenada on Tuesday nights along with his good friend, Prophet Lee Singleton. He also increased his visitation efforts in ministering to family and friends in healthcare facilities throughout Grenada and the surrounding area. He was a devoted member of the Tallahatchie District Association from 1973 until his passing. In 1998, he retired as a janitor at the Grenada High School after more than 20 years of employment.

Pastor Jones was preceded in death by his loving wife of 35 years, Nancy Aline Goss-Jones; his daughter, Glynis Jones-Bynum-Bell; as well as eleven sisters and brothers. He is survived by five sons: William Jones, Jr., Tommy Lee Jones (Suzette), Karl Bernard Jones, Everett Allen Jones (Shanda), and Charro Jones; fourteen grandchildren – Terrell Jones, Trevor Jones, Monique Bynum, A'Jahn Jones, Devan Jones, Jalyn Jones, William Jones III, Miles Jones, Annie-Sierra Jones, Charro Jones Jr., Jakaiya Jones, Cenquan Jones, Amare Jones, and Najee McClain; three greatgrandchildren – Cayson Jones, Jayden Jones, and Aubrianna Mays; three sisters, Precilla Jones-Noel (John), Mary Jones-McDowell (William), and Willie Jones-Noel (Cornelius); a host of nieces, nephews, great-nieces and great-nephews including Melzina Townes, James Jones, Stella Jones, Roy Jones, Freddie Jones, Rosie Jones-Moss, John Noel, J.T.
