But Here it starts a new*

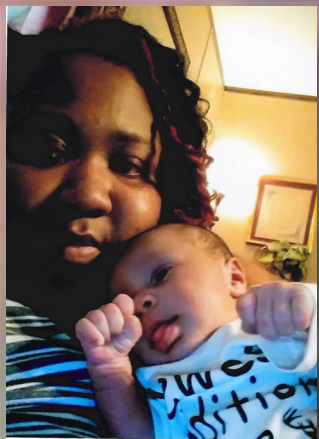
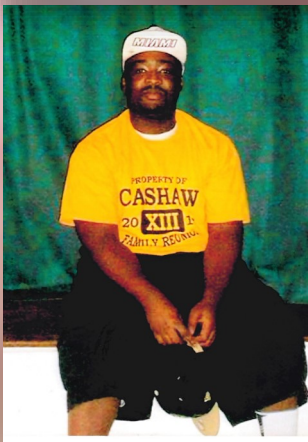
*I promise no tomorrow
