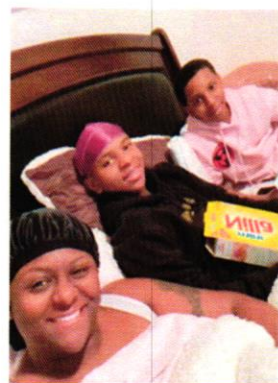
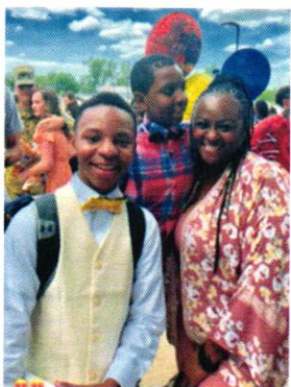

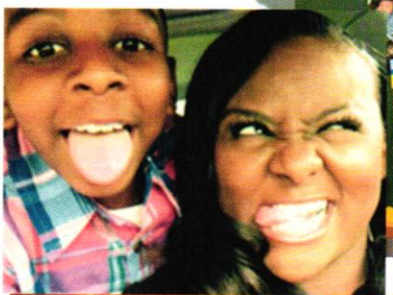
## *She's Not Gone*

when you're in need of company.

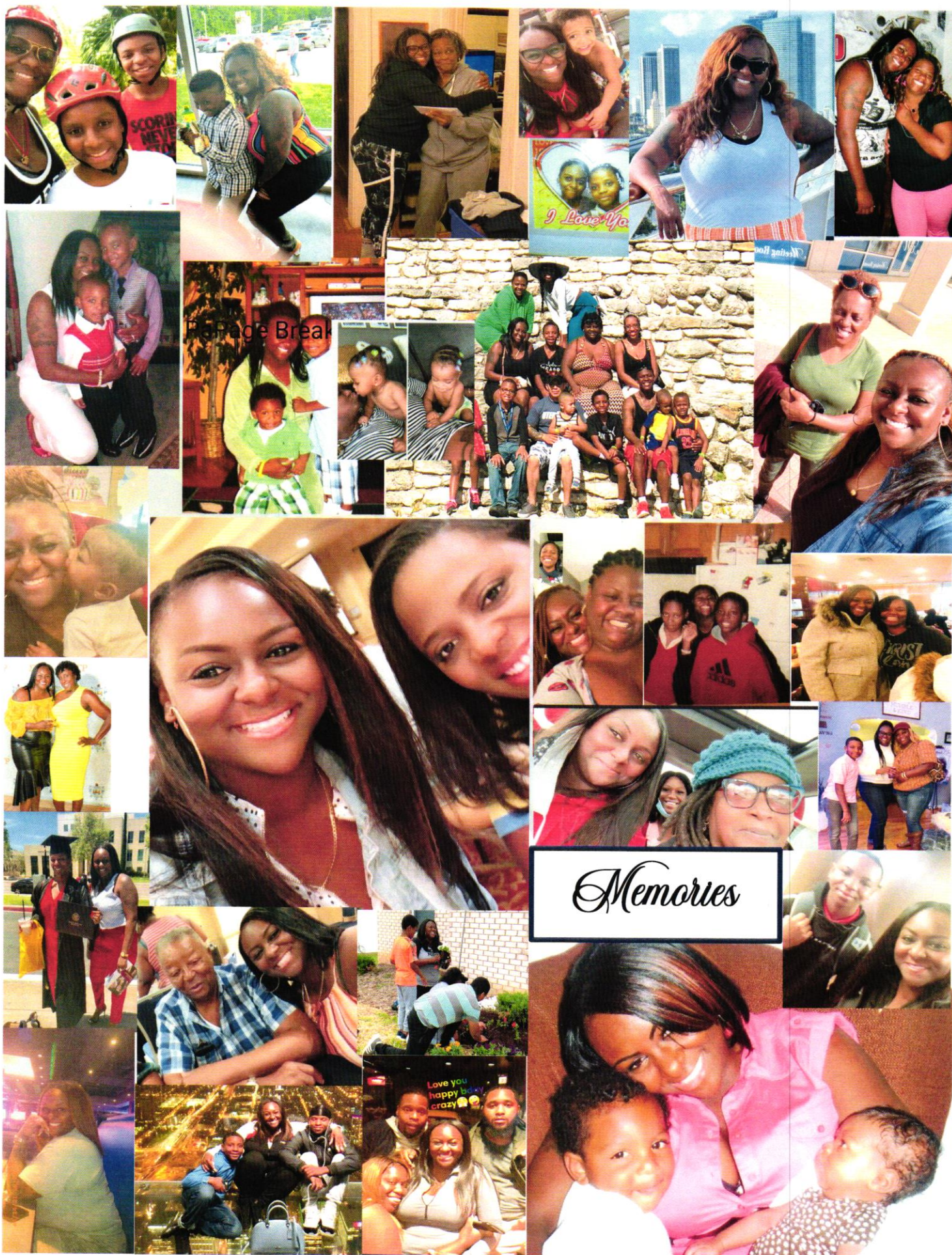
At any time you can recall,
