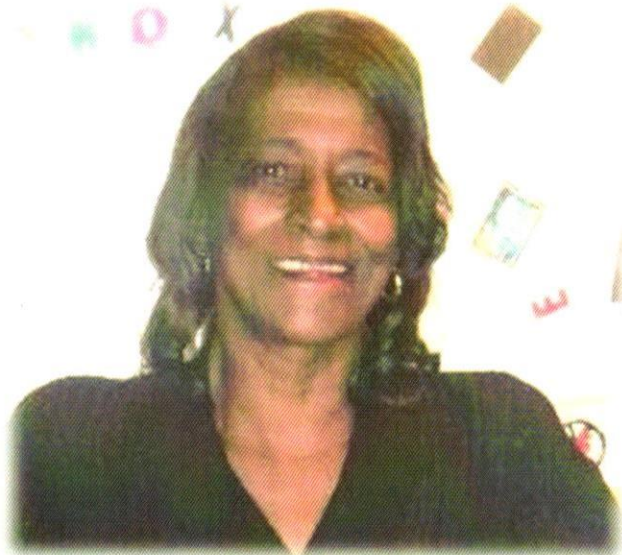

Everything is so pretty here, so white, so fresh, so new. I wish you could close your eyes so you could see it too.

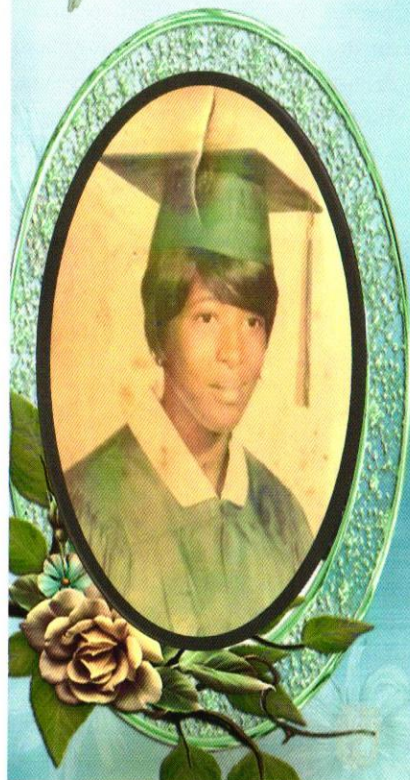
Please try not to be sad for me. Try to understand. God is taking care of me... I'm in the shelter of His hands.

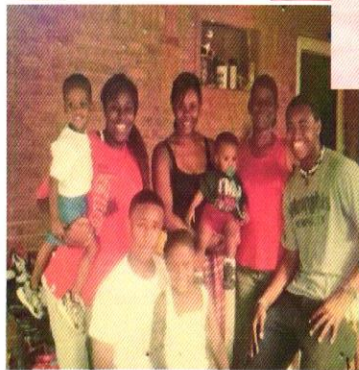

But by the look upon her face*

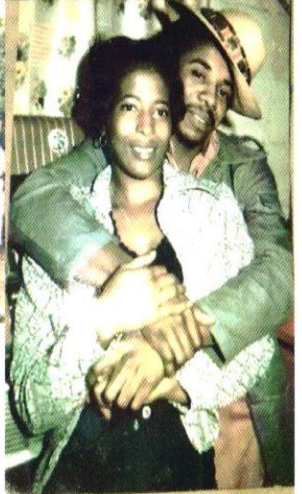
*Her touch is so gentle
